A. GENERAL

1. This Tariff Item addresses some of the definitions and conditions applicable to:

- TELUS General Tariff CRTC 1005, Item 437 Managed Digital Private Line (MDPL) Service
- TELUS General Tariff CRTC 1005, Item 440 Digital Channel Service
- TELUS General Tariff CRTC 1005, Item 446 Digital Private Line Service Extension Access Service
- TELUS General Tariff CRTC 1005, Item 448 Access Special Routing.

2. This Item is applicable in addition to the provisions specified in the respective Item associated with each of the services identified above. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between this Item and the Item specific to the service, the Item specific to the service shall apply.

"Adjoining Exchanges" are exchanges whose boundaries are common at any point, except where a boundary consists of a large natural barrier. This term is used by some Carriers other than the Company.

C. CONDITIONS

1. The Company shall determine the exchanges (i.e., Rate Centre and/or Wire Centre, as appropriate) where it will provide service. C |
2. Service is provided at the Company's discretion within such exchanges depending on the availability of suitable facilities and equipment. |
3. When it is necessary for the Company to install special equipment or to incur an unusual expense to establish service, the customer shall pay an additional charge based on the equipment installed and the unusual expense incurred. |
4. The customer is solely responsible for the installation, operation and maintenance of customer provided terminal equipment. |
5. Customer terminal equipment attached to the Company's network must be certified or connected through a certified network protection device in accordance with TELUS General Tariff CRTC 1005, Item 200. |
