

Florida College Dry Creek Camp Scholarship Application

To Applicants:

This scholarship is designed to help young people who desire to attend Florida College. Scholarships are provided by the Florida College Dry Creek Camp. These scholarships are gifts and do not have to be repaid.

Information requested on this application is of a personal and private nature. When the application is filed, the committee will study the needs of each applicant and determine the recipients of the scholarships. Access to information on the application will be limited to the committee. In some cases, the committee may request further information in the form of transcripts, written letter, or other information.

General Conditions:

1. The Scholarship for the **2026-2027** academic year is a maximum of \$4000 (\$2000 each semester) availability of funds permitting. All qualified campers will receive a scholarship although some may receive more than others based upon their application.
2. The Scholarship is valid only for students who attend Florida College.
3. Applicants must have attained a 2.0 average on High School work.
4. Students who are on probation for any semester in which they receive a Dry Creek Scholarship will not be entitled to a scholarship the following semester, even though the scholarship may have been previously awarded.
5. Applicants must have attended the Dry Creek Camp their senior year.
6. Announcement of scholarship winners will be made at the Camp.
