- MARCH 31** **ALPHA CLUB APPLICATION DEADLINE** – For all returning senior campers who want to serve in the Alpha Club.
- APRIL 1** **APPLICATION DEADLINE** – If you complete your Online Application by this date, you will have done all that you can do to ensure acceptance into the Camp.
ALL CAMP GRANT REQUEST FORMS DUE
- APRIL 15** **ACCEPTANCE/WAITING LIST NOTIFICATIONS:**
- Email Notices – Emailed to the email address you used on your Application.
- MAY 1** **ALL FEES OR AGREED PAYMENT PLAN DUE** – All fees paid in full or Payment Plan in place, or subject to being placed on the Waiting List.
- MAY 10** **CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS:**
- All applicants who cancel on or before this date will receive a full refund less a \$25 application fee.
 - After this date a full refund less a \$50 cancelation fee will be refunded.
- MAY 26** After this date there is no refund.
- All refunds are mailed after Camp.**
