Booking Hotels

At this busy time of year, many MPs, or MPs' staff, may be searching for London hotel rooms. The financial limit for these is £150 per night. These can be booked via the House of Commons' travel provider, Chambers, or by searching online or contacting a hotel directly. The cost of online or direct reservations can be claimed from IPSA and you can make bookings using your IPSA Payment Card.

Online Payroll Resources

We have recently updated the payroll related resources available on our website to make it easier to find up to date information more quickly and easily.

We have a <u>Job Description Tool</u> and a <u>Staff Contract Tool</u> that enables an MP's office to easily and quickly produce the job descriptions and contracts they need for new and current staff.
