### **New IPSA website**

A reminder that IPSA's new public website is now live in *beta* (draft) form. The website is now available to review at <a href="www.theipsa.org.uk">www.theipsa.org.uk</a>. We will promote the new website in the coming weeks after we publish MPs' annual expenditure for 2015-16. This is scheduled for 17 November 2016.

Our website helps us meet IPSA's statutory objective of providing assurance to the public that MPs' expenditure is appropriate and independently regulated. As such, we have upgraded and simplified the layout of the website to make it easier to see that your expenditure is wholly and exclusively for parliamentary purposes, including a dedicated page on each MP's spending. There is also space for any commentary from MPs which we are currently piloting. We have included a graph showing each MP's annual expenditure in order to demonstrate to the public that the majority of your money is spent on your staff to support your parliamentary and constituency work and virtually none on 'expenses'.
