What is an EFT?

- Access funds on the same day of the deposit.
- Increase efficiency and improve cash flow.

How Do I Enroll?

- Email us a copy of your W-9 (must be dated within the past 6 months).
- Send us a copy of your Bank Letter that contains your banking information or a voided check.
- Please allow 7-10 business days for processing.
