Mark Twain (1847)

Monkey Shoulder Scotch, Lemon, Simple Syrup and Bitters.

Airmail (1949)

Mt. Gay Eclipse Rum, Lime, Honey and Champagne.
The classic cocktail that celebrated the first attempt to deliver mail by airplane. 17

Champs-Élysées (1930)

Remy Martin VSOP, Yellow Chartreuse, Lemon, Simple Syrup and Bitters.
Named for the elegant Parisian Avenue. 17

Aviation (1916)

Empress 1908 Gin, Maraschino Liqueur, Violette Liqueur, Lemon and Simple Syrup.
The first bartender "handshake" in the finest of cocktail bars pre-prohibition. 17

Bamboo Cocktail (1890)

Lustau Oloroso Sherry, Yzaguirre Blanco, Vermouth and Bitters.
An elegant cocktail created in the 1890s in Japan to appease the visiting dignitaries to the Grand Hotel in Yokohama. 17

Old Pal (1922)

Templeton Rye, Dolin Blanc and Campari.
An Ode to famed journalist William "Sparrow" Robertson. 17

Organic Hardy Cognac, Elation Pear Cognac with Bitters, Lemon and Coconut Chai Syrup.
