- Dogs are not allowed in restaurants or other food and beverage areas, on the casino floor or gaming areas, or in the pool or fitness center areas, unless credentialed as a service animal.
- Guests are responsible for dog waste clean-up inside the Hotel and throughout the property grounds.
- Guests are responsible for any personal injury and/or property damage related to or caused by their dog(s).
- If your dog becomes ill or if the state of the animal's health otherwise requires professional attention, in its sole discretion, The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas may engage the services of a veterinarian for the attention of the animal, and the expenses thereof shall be paid by the owner. This includes diarrhea, vomiting, and coughing as well as any other illness.
- Guest agrees to indemnify and hold harmless The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas, its members, operators, owners, affiliates, and employees from any and all liability and/or damage suffered as a result of their dogs(s).
- The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas reserves the right to remove guests whose dogs are deemed noisy or disruptive, from the room.
