



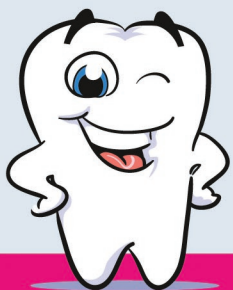
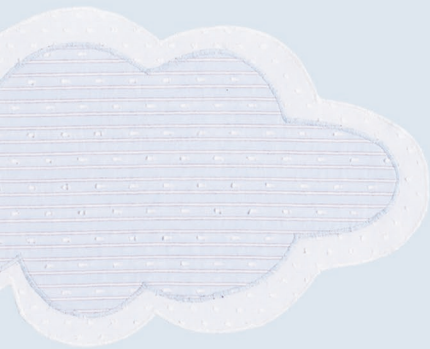
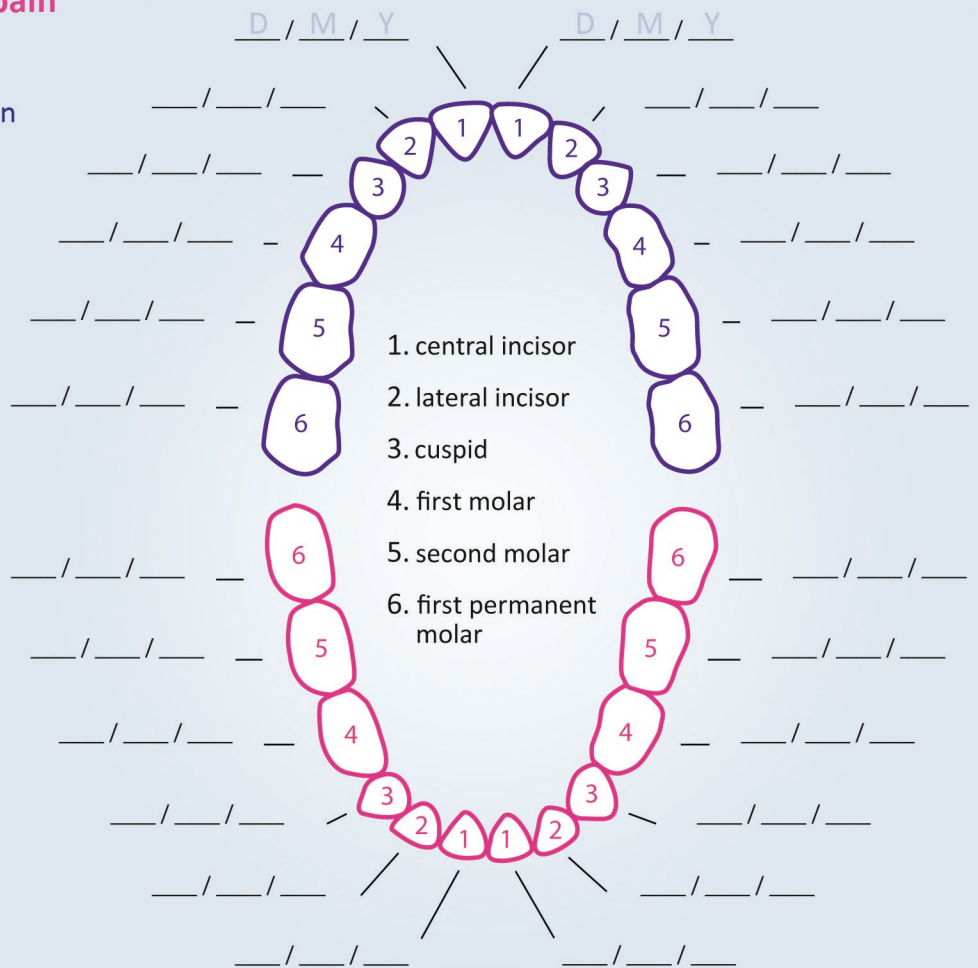
TEETHING CHART



Babies' teeth usually start to appear between the age of six and nine months. Your baby's first tooth is a major milestone in their first year, and a moment to treasure! To keep track of when your baby's teeth appear, simply colour in the corresponding teeth on the chart and record the dates.
