

MONEY CAN'T BUY HAPPINESS...

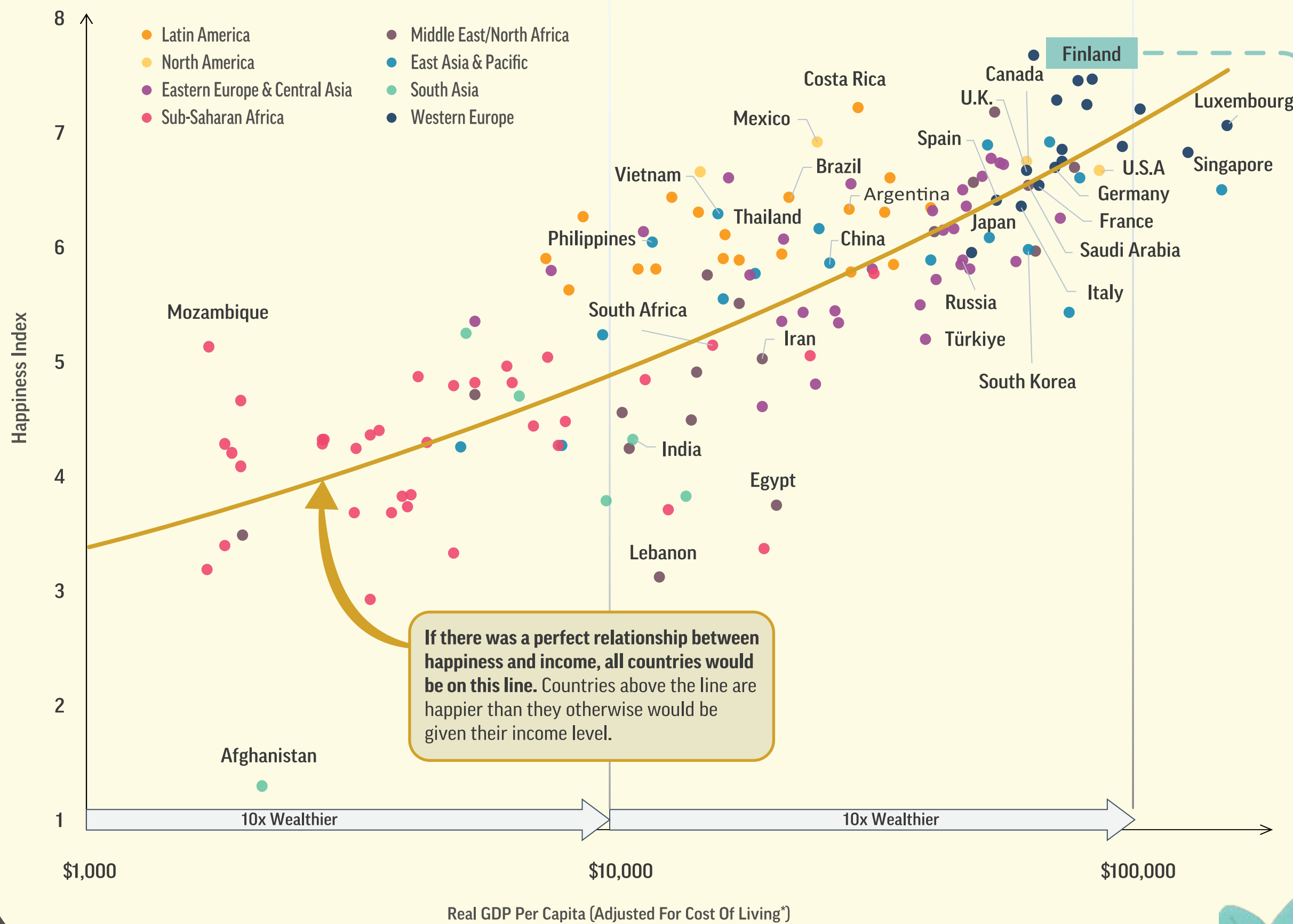

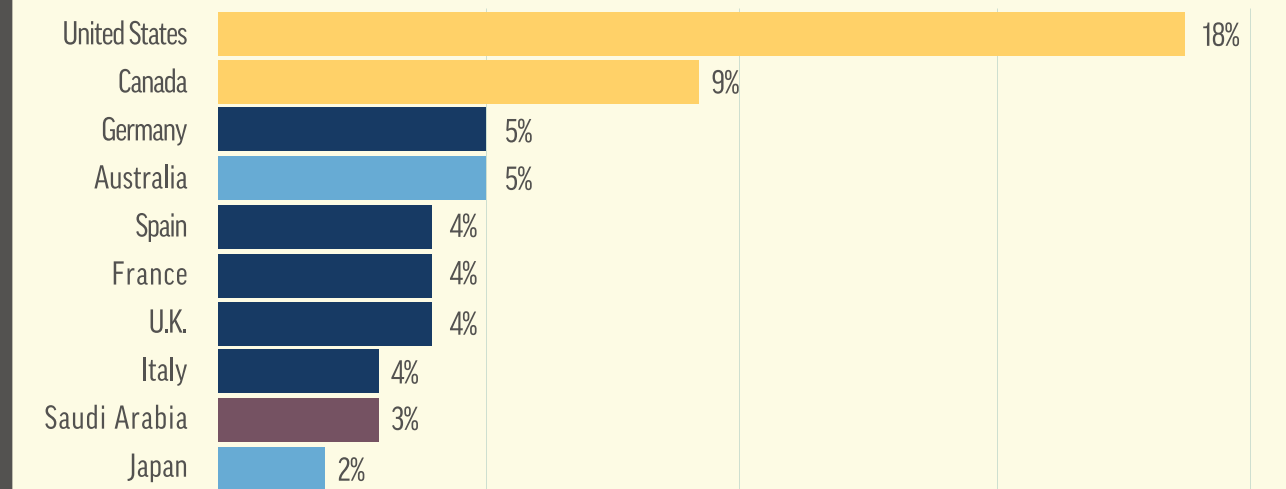
