Fruit Tree Giveaway

The Arbor Lodge Tree Team completed another successful Brian Duncan Memorial Fruit Tree Giveaway on Saturday, March 9, 2024. They distributed 57 fruit trees, 50 blueberry bushes, and 4 large yard trees. Each plant came with a watering bucket filled with bark mulch for planting. The Tree Team provided handouts and individual coaching on the plant needs, where to plant in the yard, and ongoing care, like watering.

This November the Tree Team will host a Fruit Tree & Blueberry Social, inviting anyone who has received a plant over the past 6 years, and anyone interested in one in the future. It'll be a chance to learn from others, share what you've learned as tree caregivers, how you've used your harvest, and just get to know your neighbors.

Shelter Mural Painting

With the Arbor Lodge Shelter construction expected to complete this spring, the artist group Que Lo Gi has begun work on the mural that will adorn the renovated shelter. As part of their work, Que Lo Gi is inviting neighbors to contribute to the mural with their own paintings inside the design itself. There are three dates scheduled. Painting will be done at the Kenton Firehouse, 8105 N Brandon. Materials and food will be provided, all ages welcome!

The mural design was inspired by the Vietnamese proverb, "When the pain has passed, one forgets the medicine" Que Lo Gi roots itself in healing practices and seeing people as they are - and not defined by our traumas. Who are we individually and collectively with and beyond our traumas? With our guiding values, they spent 3 months of research and engagement with the Kenton and Arbor Lodge community to create a mural design that is a reflection on how direct and indirect community members make space for each other with and beyond trauma.
