

Leonard Glass, M.D., F.A.C.E., Senior Vice President of Medical Affairs, Eli Lilly and Company

Leonard Glass, M.D., F.A.C.E. is senior vice president of medical affairs at Eli Lilly and Company, where he oversees the flow of scientific information and clinical expertise between Lilly Diabetes and the medical community. He is an endocrinologist with a special interest in physiology, insulin resistance syndrome, and type 1 and type 2 diabetes.

Glass started his career with Lilly in 2004 and has held several positions including leading the US Diabetes Medical Affairs organization. In 2015 he left Lilly briefly before returning in 2016 as the Diabetes Therapeutic Area Lead for Lilly International. In 2018, Glass joined the newly formed Clinical Development Design Hub where he built and managed a group responsible for the novel design and execution of Phase 1 – 4 clinical trials for diabetes and metabolism. In 2020 Glass moved into his current role, where he leads and oversees the Lilly Diabetes Global Medical Affairs organization. Prior to joining Lilly, Glass was an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Miami School of Medicine.

Glass earned his Bachelor of Science in biology from the University of Miami and went on to receive his Doctor of Medicine from Eastern Virginia Medical School. He completed his internal medicine residency and clinical research fellowship in endocrinology, diabetes and metabolism at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. Glass is also a Fellow of the American Association of Clinical Endocrinology (FACE), which recognizes achievement and leadership in the field of endocrinology.
