



California Voluntary Carbon Markets Disclosure (AB 1305)

In 2024, Lilly did not purchase or use voluntary carbon offsets within the State of California.

Section 44475.2 information:

Lilly has set decarbonization targets, and reports on its progress, to (1) source 100% of purchased electricity from renewable sources by 2030, and (2) to be carbon neutral in our own operations (Scope 1 and 2 emissions) by 2030. An independent third party performs a limited assurance engagement over Lilly’s greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reporting annually; the most recent assurance report can be found [here](#) (the “Third-Party Assurance Report”). The Third-Party Assurance Report covers total Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions, purchased electricity from renewable sources and Lilly’s calculated interim progress toward the targets referenced above.
