- Question #1 What are the potential benefits and risks of joining the trial?
- Question #2 What's the goal of this specific cancer research study?
- Question #3 How many patients before me have received this research treatment, and how did they do?
- Question #4 What are the different treatment groups in the trial?
- Question #5 How many months will the clinical trial take?
- Question #6 Who will be running the cancer study, and what will they be responsible for?
- Question #7 Who do I contact if there's an emergency?
- Question #8 Is there anything I can't do while I am in the cancer clinical trial?
- Question #9 Can I withdraw from the study at any point in time?
- Question #10 What will I need to do if I decide to take part in the clinical trial?
- Question #11 Am I eligible to participate?
- Question #12 Why am I a good fit for this study?
- Question #13 What do I have to do to be a participant in the trial?
- Question #14 Do I need to travel for study visits, and how often will they be?
- Question #15 Will it cost me money to participate?
- Question #16 Will I receive any financial support to participate in the study?
- Question #17 Who can I contact if I have any questions?
- Question #18 Will my personal information be secure and/or shared?
