

UNDERCOVER JOURNALIST RESPONSIBILITIES

- Spending time in the field building both short-term and long-term relationships with subjects.
- Developing and living a cover, adopting an alias persona, and gaining access to an identified person, place or organization.
- Obtaining video proof showing waste, fraud, abuse, corruption and other misconduct in a variety
 of public and private institutions.
- Following guidelines, objectives, goals, deadlines and deliverables.
- Observing all applicable Federal and state laws with guidance of PV counsel and management.
- Conducting research Planning an investigation Preparing a background story to support your role • Gaining an appointment or access to the subject of the investigation • Operating covert recording equipment and utilizing disguise • Writing detailed reports and operational plans
- Working alongside an Executive Producer and assisting the production team in compiling the final video.

REQUIRED SKILL SETS:

The candidate must demonstrate an unwavering dedication and commitment to the Project Veritas mission and vision of its Leadership.

Full-time candidates will be expected to travel extensively – often with limited notice. Candidates may not be able to share the details of their employment and operations with those outside their immediate family.
