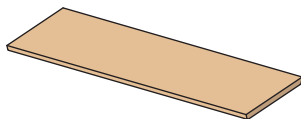
Take care during assembly. Do not dispose of any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is completed to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware. Avoid balancing unsupported pieces and do not bend over around unsecured pieces. Keep children out of the way during assembly.

To prevent injury or damage from unexpected tipping of furniture, secure the Pillar Bookshelf to the wall using anti-tipping hardware.

Number of pieces included is determined by the product configuration purchased.

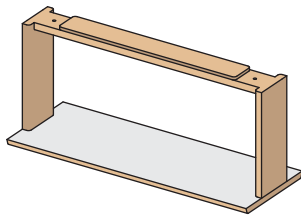
Top tray



Short screw



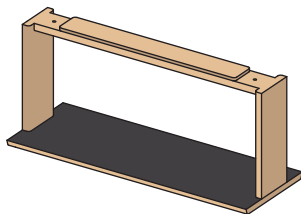
Stacking unit



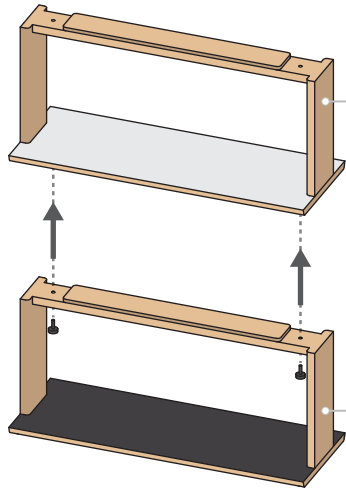
C-clip

Base Units & Stacking Units



Stacking units are labeled with a white sheet.

These units stack on top of other units.
Do not place on the floor.

Base units are weighted and labeled with a black sheet.

These units are to be placed on the floor.
Do not stack on top of other units.

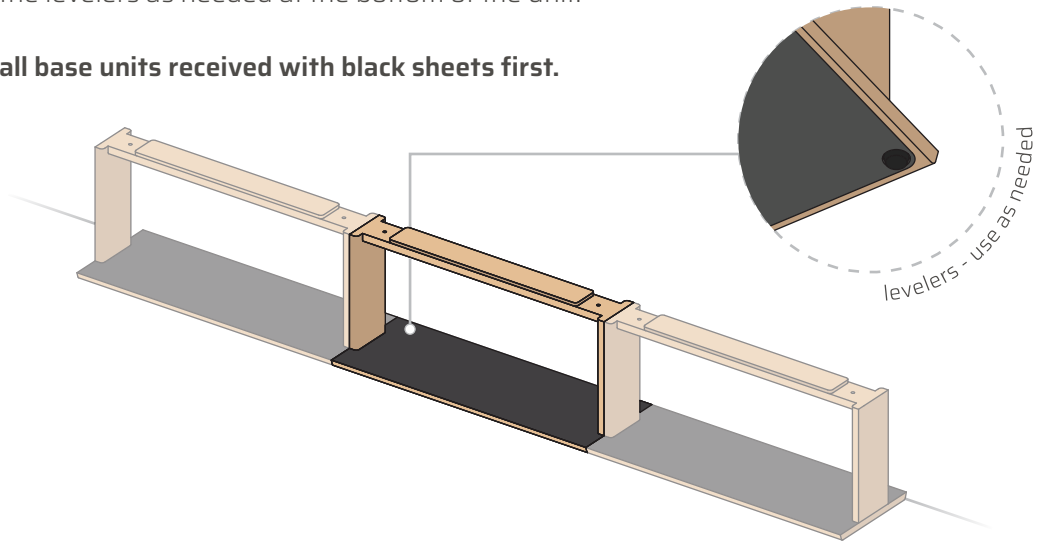
Step 1

Lay out all pieces.

Place the **base unit** at desired location.

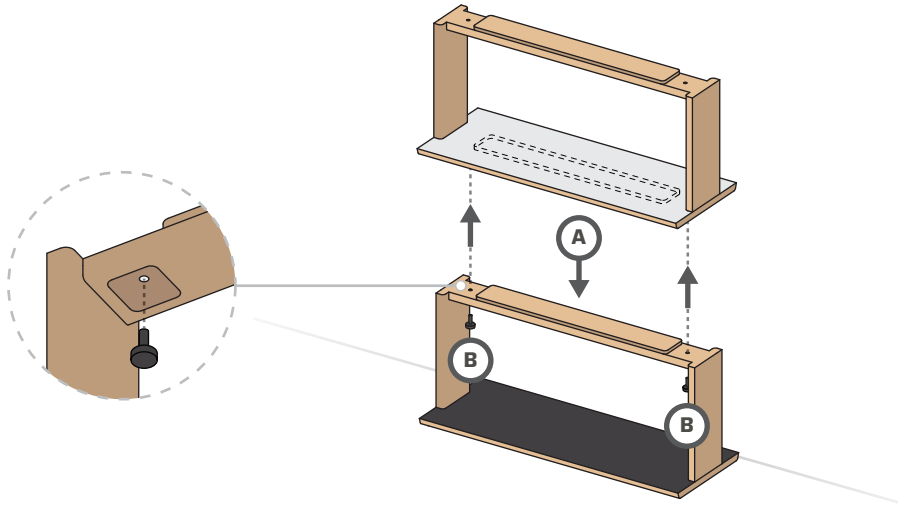
Adjust the levelers as needed at the bottom of the unit.

Set up all base units received with black sheets first.



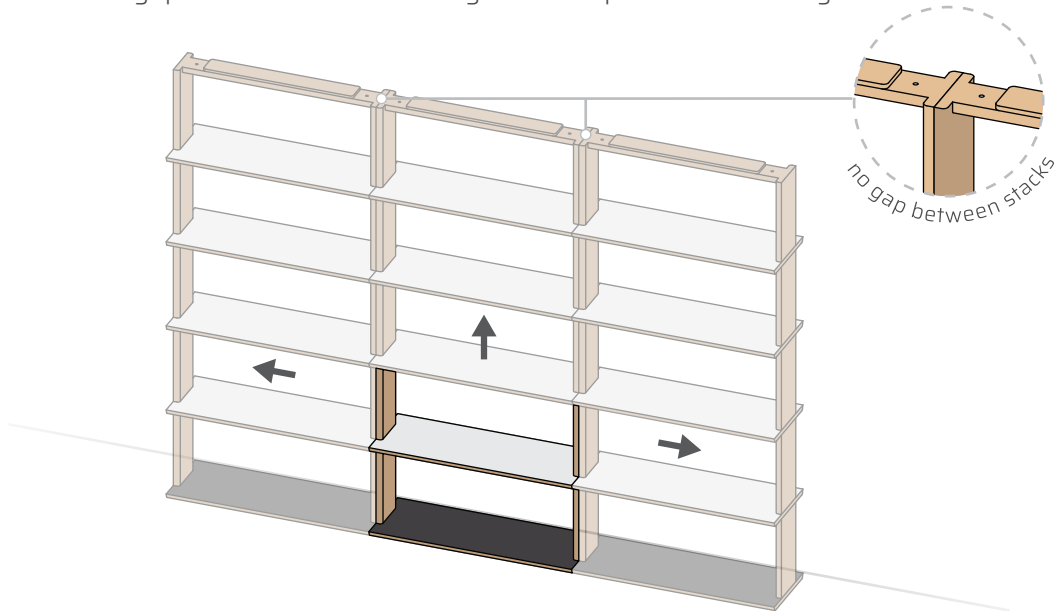
Step 2

- A. Lift a **stacking unit** and place on top of **base unit**.
Check all sides to ensure stacking unit is properly nested.
- B. Use two **short screws** under the beam of the base unit to secure the two units together.
Tighten by hand.



Step 3

Repeat stacking and securing units until desired configuration is reached.
Ensure there is no gap between stacks if configuration expands horizontally.

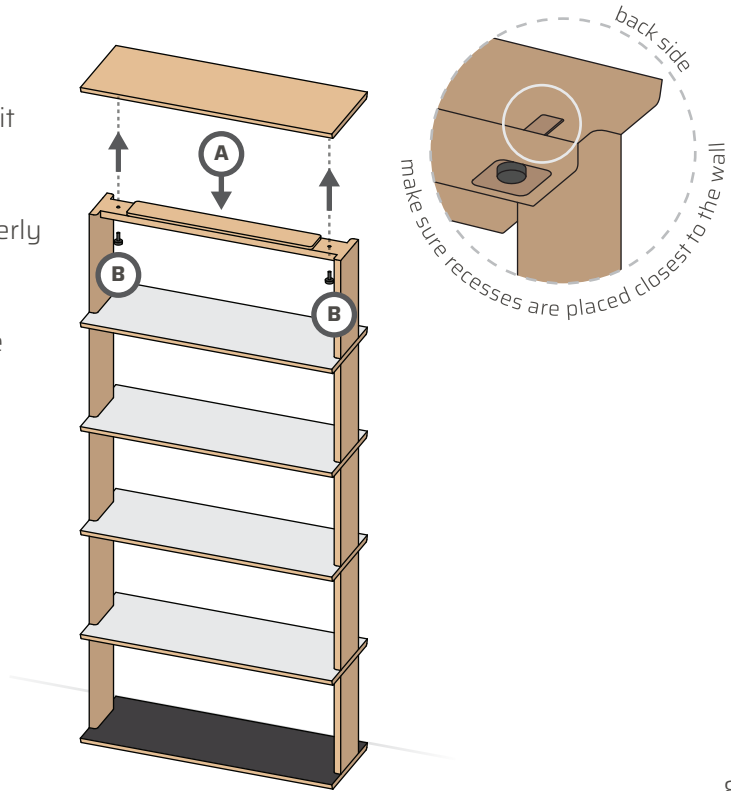


Step 4

- A. Place **top tray** onto topmost unit with the recesses on the side closest to the wall. Check on all sides to ensure top tray is properly nested.
- B. Use two short screws under the beam of the topmost shelf to secure the top tray to the Pillar Bookshelf. Tighten by hand.

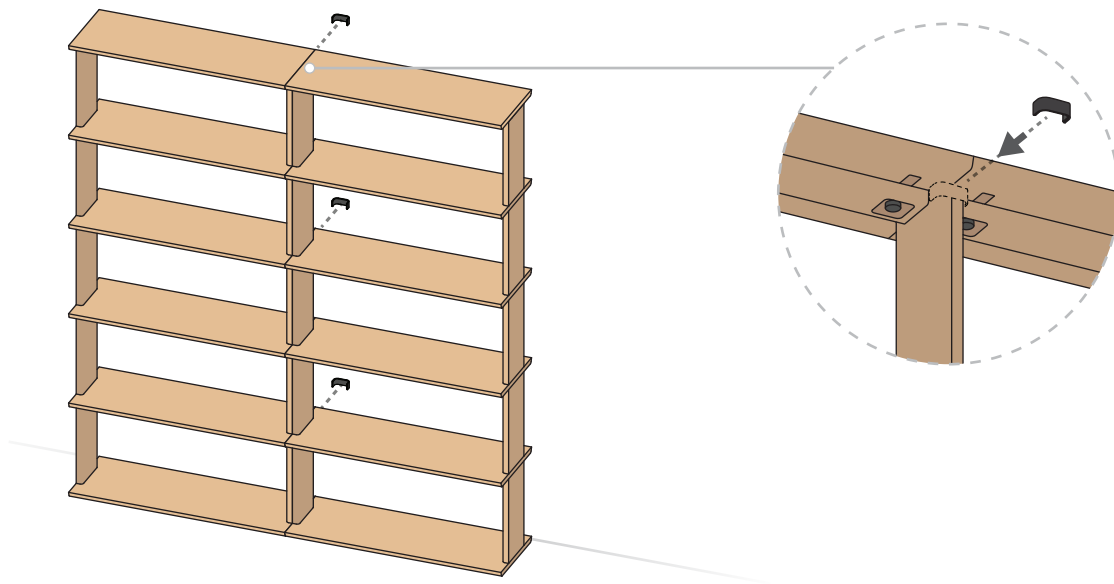
Repeat step as needed.

Remove all sheets.



Step 5

For configurations with more than one stack, use **c-clips** for better alignment. Place them at the back of the pillar, directly under the shelves as needed.



Anti-Tipping Hardware

To prevent injury or damage from unexpected tipping of furniture, secure the Pillar Bookshelf to the wall using anti-tipping hardware.

Number of pieces included is determined by the product configuration purchased.

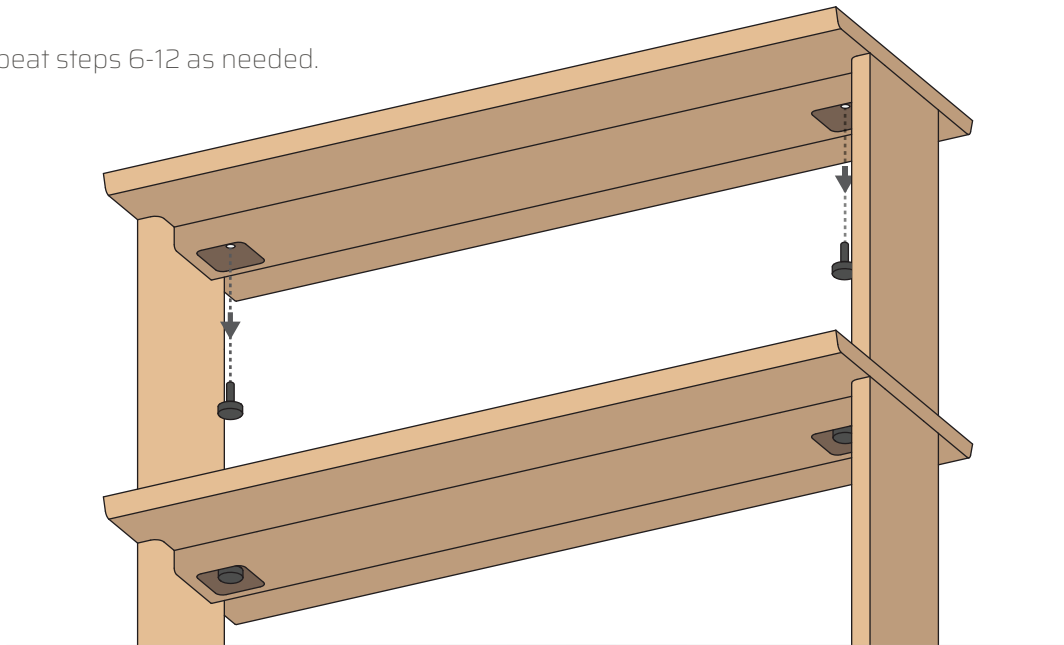

Step 6

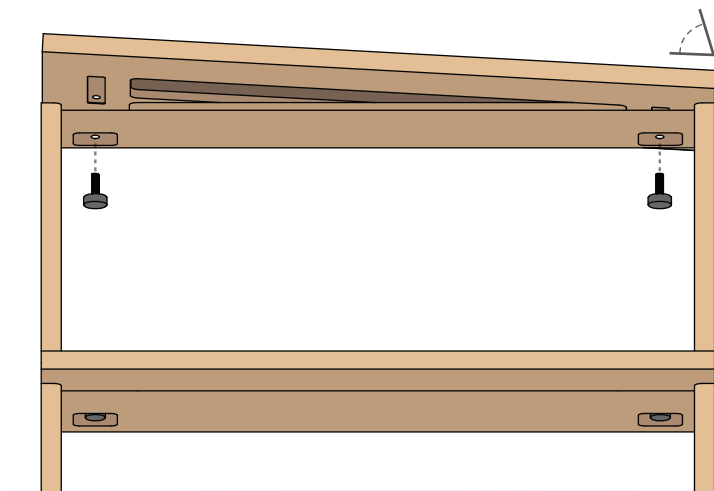
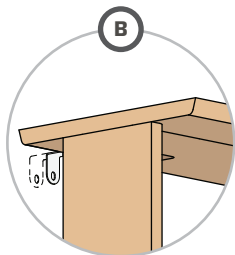
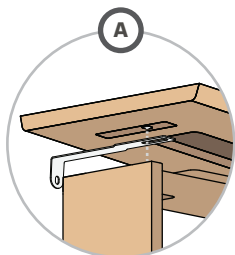
Unscrew the topmost short screws.

Repeat steps 6-12 as needed.



Step 7

- A. Tilt top tray and nest the wall anchor plate. Repeat on the other side.
- B. Adjust the plates to contact the wall then secure with short screws.



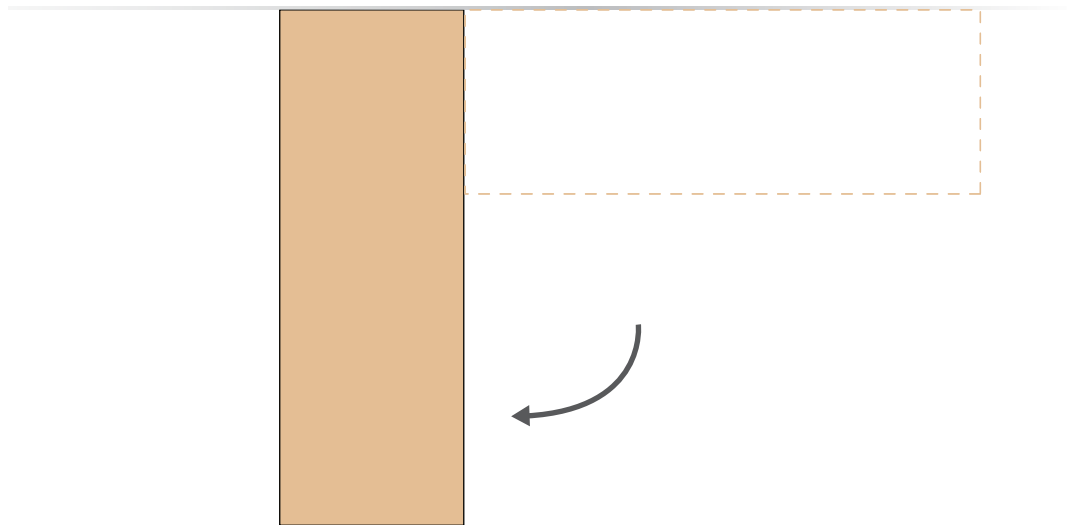
Step 8

Mark on the wall through the plate openings.



Step 9

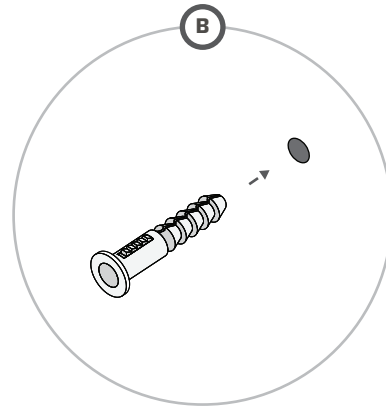
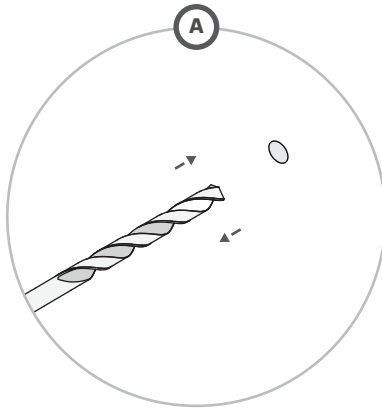
Rotate the product so it sits at a 90° angle from the wall.



Step 10

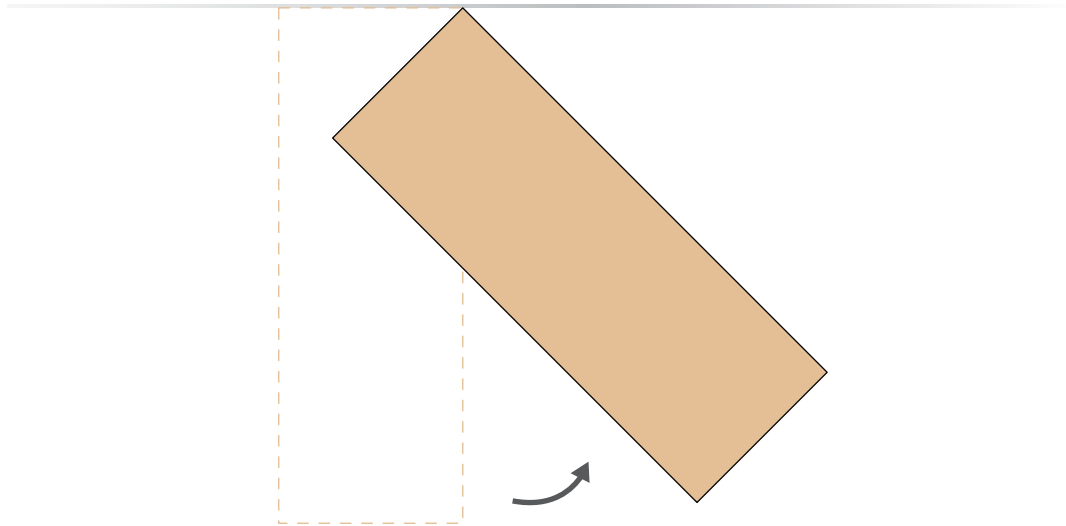
A. Drill holes in wall with a 19/64" drill bit.

B. Hammer the wall anchors into the holes.



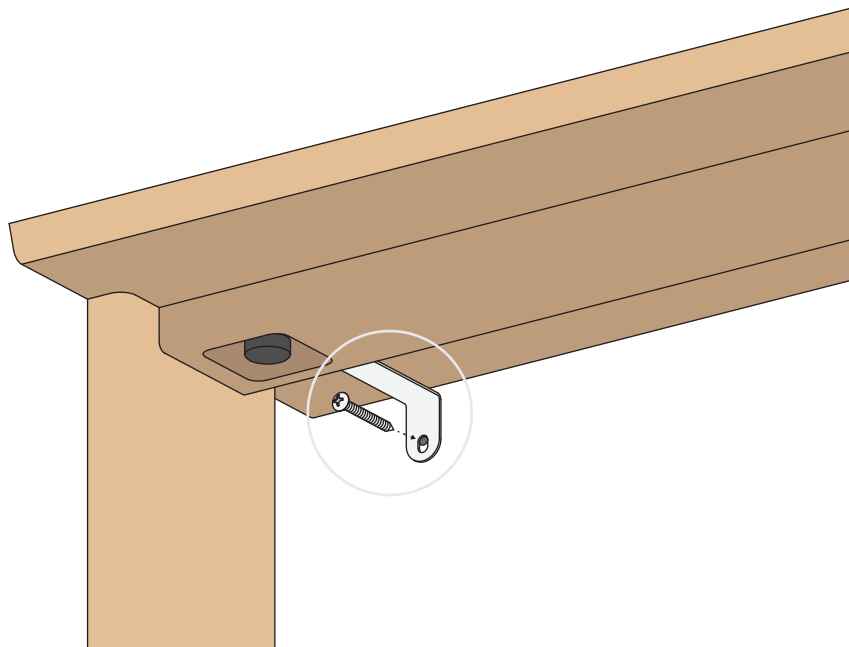
Step 11

Rotate the product toward the wall.



Step 12

Secure the wall anchor plates with wall screws.



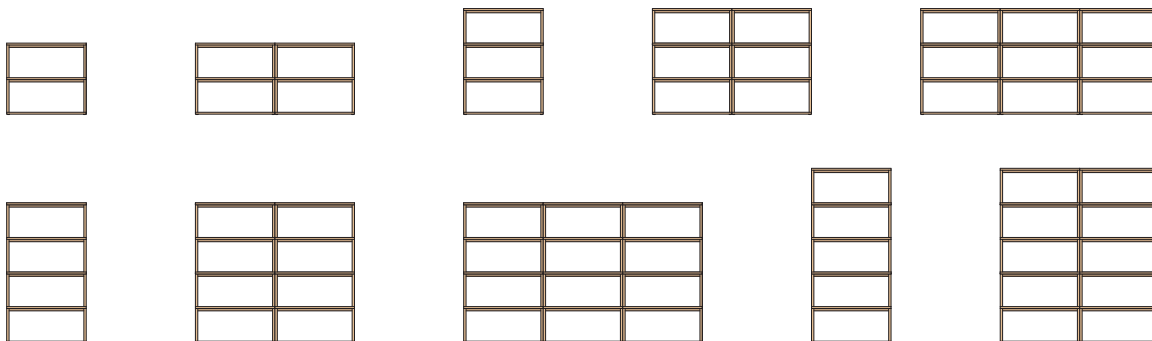
