GET UP & MOVE!

A physical activity to help lock Colossians 1:28 in your memory.

WARN, TEACH, PROCLAIM!

An action-word movement game • All ages • 5–10 min • No prep needed

SETUP — LEARN THE MOVES

Teach everyone three actions before you start: PROCLAIM = cup hands around mouth like shouting. WARN = wag one finger. TEACH = mime writing on a hand like a chalkboard. Practice each move twice together.

ROUND 1 — MOVE WITH THE WORDS

Read the verse together slowly. Every time you hit the word "proclaim," do the PROCLAIM move. Every "warning" or "warn" gets the WARN move. Every "teaching" or "teach" gets the TEACH move. Go through the verse 2–3 times until the moves feel natural.

ROUND 2 — LEADER CALLS IT

One person is the leader. They call out "PROCLAIM," "WARN," or "TEACH" at random — everyone else does the move AND says that part of the verse. Switch leaders each round. Go faster each time!

ROUND 3 — SAY IT BY HEART

No reading! Say the whole verse together from memory while doing the moves at the right moments. If anyone misses a move, the whole group starts the verse over. Celebrate when you make it all the way through!

LEADER TIP

After the game, ask: "Paul says we proclaim Christ by warning AND teaching everyone. Why does he say 'everyone' three times? Who is the 'everyone' in your life?"
