THE DISCIPLE RELAY

A tag & recite relay • All ages • 5–10 min • Needs open floor space

SETUP

Clear a space and designate two spots — a START line and a GO line about 10 feet apart. Split into two teams (or play as one family). Everyone reads the passage together once before the relay begins.

HOW TO PLAY

Player 1 stands at the START line and says the first sentence of the passage from memory. If correct, they RUN to the GO line and back, then tag Player 2. Player 2 says the next sentence, runs, and tags Player 3. Continue until the whole passage is said. If someone gets stuck, the team says the sentence together — then they run anyway!

ROUND 2 — GO FASTER

Play again and time yourselves. Can your team say the whole passage AND complete all the runs in under 60 seconds? Each player must still say their sentence correctly before running.

ROUND 3 — BACKWARDS RELAY

This time, start from the last sentence and work backwards to the first. It sounds impossible — but it forces you to really know every part of the passage, not just the beginning!

LEADER TIP

After the relay, ask: "Jesus says GO — the relay made you GO too! Where is one place you will GO this week where you can show someone Jesus loves them?"
