PASS THE GOOD NEWS

A circle passing game • All ages • 5-10 min • No prep needed

SETUP

Sit or stand in a circle. One person holds a ball (or any object). That object is "the good news." Everyone reads the full passage together once before starting.

HOW TO PLAY

The person holding the ball says the first word of the passage ("How"), then passes it to the next person who says the second word ("then"), and so on around the circle. Keep going until the whole passage is said. If someone gets stuck, the group says the word together — no one is left behind!

ROUND 2 — SPEED IT UP

Play again, but this time try to go faster. Count how many seconds it takes to get through the whole passage. Can you beat your time on the next round?

ROUND 3 — NO PEEKING

Flip the paper over so the verse is hidden. Play one more time from memory as a group. Celebrate together when you make it all the way through!

LEADER TIP

After the game, ask: "What does it mean that someone had to be SENT? Who sent them? Who sends us?"
