## AN ACT

RELATING to Motor Vehicles; Making it Unlawful for a Minor to Purchase, Possess, Transport, Use, or Have Under His Control in a Motor Vehicle any Spirituous Liquor or Narcotic Drug or Dangerous Drug or Cannabis; Providing for Suspension of License, and Amending Title 28, Chapter 6, Article 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, by Adding Section 28-692.02.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this act is to make it a misdemeanor for a minor to purchase, possess, transport, use or have under his control in a motor vehicle any spirituous liquor or parcotic drug or dangerous drug, including the plant cannabis and any substances of such plant. The act turther provides for suspension of license upon conviction of any person in violation of any provision of this section.

Sec. 2. Fitle 28, chapter 6, article 5, Arizona Kevised statutes, is amended by adding Section 28-692.02, to read:

NEW STC. 28-692.02, PURCHASE, POSSESSION, TRANSPORTATION, USE OF CONTROL OF LIQUOR OR NARCOTIC DRUG OR DANGEROUS DRUG OR CANNABIS IN MOTOR VEHICLE BY MINOR, PENALTY; SUSPENSION OF LICENSE.

A. No person under twenty-one years of age shall purchase or knowingly possess, transport, use, or have under his control in any motor vehicle any spirituous liquor or narcotic drug or dangerous drug or cannabis or any substances of such plant.

B. A person who violates any provision of subsection A is guilty of

a misdemeanor.

C. Within ten days following the conviction of any person for the violation of the provisions of this section, the clerk of the court or ofb. (designated officer shall transmit a copy of the order of conviction or other evidence thereof to the superintendent of the motor vehicle d. Sion of the highway department, who shall suspend the license of such person in the manner prescribed by the terms of Section 28-446, for a period of not less than thirty days or more than one year.

D. For the purpose of this se tion, "cannabis", as defined in Section 36-1001, paragraph 13, "dangerous drug", as defined in Section 32-1964, subsection "A", paragraphs 1, 3, and 7, and "narcotic drug" as defined in Section 36-1001, paragraph 14, shall be applicable to the provisions of this section.
