

1 1. Under the power of the referendum, as vested in the legisla-
2 ture, the following advisory question shall be submitted to the quali-
3 fied electors of this state for the purpose of obtaining their recommen-
4 dations to the legislature as to whether or not the legislature should
5 ratify the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States
6 of America:

7 "ADVISORY QUESTION

8 DO YOU RECOMMEND THAT THE ARIZONA LEGISLATURE SHOULD RATIFY THE
9 FOLLOWING PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES
10 WHICH PROVIDES THAT EQUALITY OF RIGHTS UNDER THE LAW SHALL NOT BE
11 DENIED OR ABRIDGED BY THE UNITED STATES OR BY ANY STATE ON ACCOUNT OF
12 SEX?

13 ARTICLE

14 "Section 1. Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied
15 or abridged by the United States or by any state on account of sex.

16 "Section 2. The Congress shall have the power to enforce, by
17 appropriate legislation, the provisions of this article.

18 "Section 3. This amendment shall take effect two years after
19 the date of ratification.

20 If you recommend that the legislature should ratify the proposed
21 amendment, vote 'YES', if not, vote 'NO'."

22 2. The secretary of state is directed to submit said advisory
23 question to the people at the polls, and to cause to be printed on the
24 official ballot at the next regular general election the title and
25 number thereof, in the same manner as provided for measures pursuant to
26 section 1, part 1, article IV, Constitution of Arizona.
