AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS AND CIVIL PROCEEDINGS; INCREASING THE PERCENTAGE OF FEES SET APART FOR COUNTY LAW LIBRARY FUND, AND AMENDING SECTION 12-305, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
- 2 Section 1. Section 12-305, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
- 3 amended to read:
 - 12-305. Law library fund
- A. There shall be set apart to a county law library fund bwenty-five FORTY per cent of all fees collected by the clerk of the superior court in each county.
- B. The county law library fund shall be used for the pur-9 chase of books for a county law library under the direction of 30 a judge of the superior court in and for the county. The monies 31 in the fund shall be paid out only upon the order of the judge
- 2 directed to the county treasurer.
- 13 C. When the county law library fund at the close of the
- 14 fiscal year exceeds three thousand dollars, the board of super-
- 15 visors may by resolution adopted by vote of the members, and
- 16 with the concurrence of the judge of the superior court in and
- 17 for the county, transfer the surplus of the fund in the excess
- 18 of three thousand dollars to a fund known as the building re-
- 19 pair fund. Monies so transferred shall be expended only for
- 23 additions, alterations and repairs to the court house. The

- 1 fund shall be exempt from the provisions of sections 42-303
- 2 and 42-308 relating to county budgets, but its expenditure
- 3 shall be subject to provisions of law relating to advertising
- 4 and calling for bids.
