Project Overview

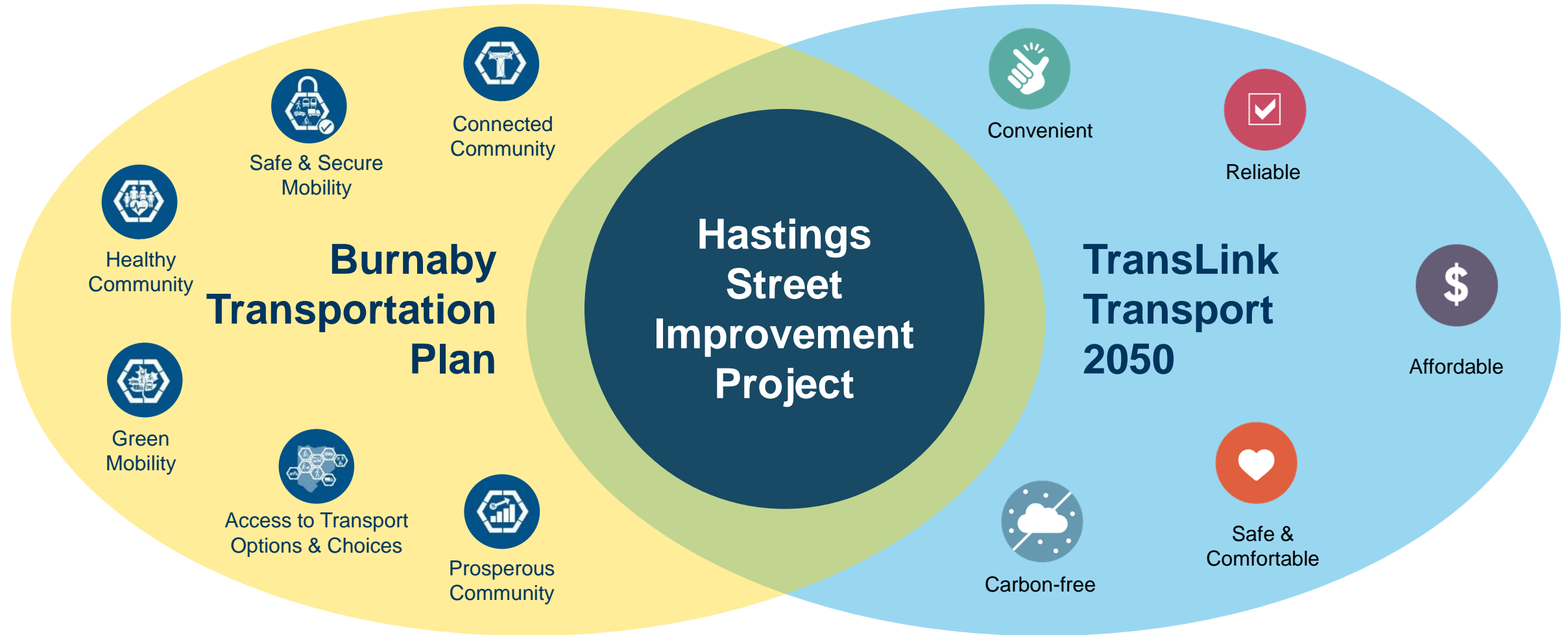
TransLink and the City of Burnaby are **partnering to study street improvements** on Hastings Street between Boundary Road & Duthie Avenue.

The objective is to implement improvements **over the next three to five years.**

Improve **bus priority**



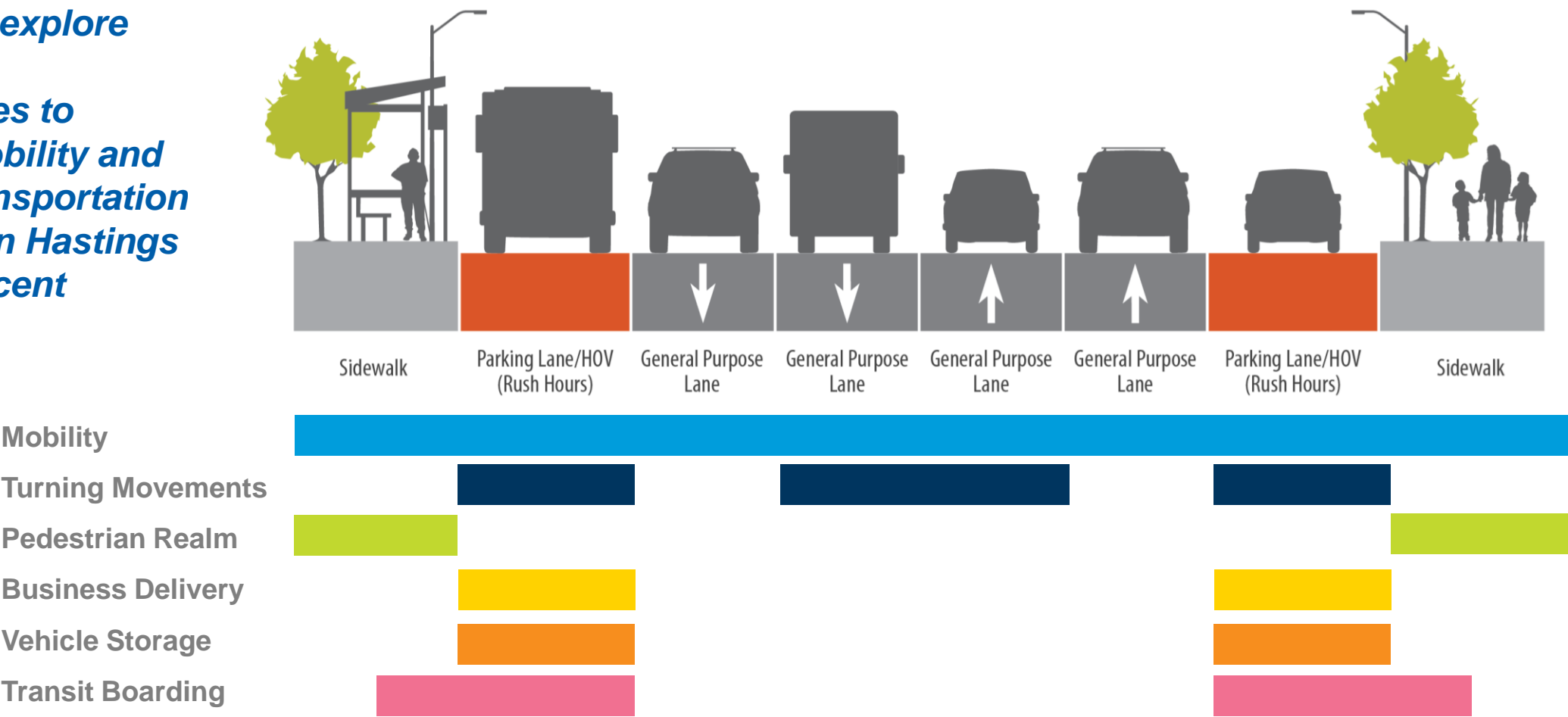
Improve **active transportation** facilities

Hastings Street Has Many Functions

Project will explore near-term opportunities to improve mobility and balance transportation functions on Hastings St and adjacent streets.



Hastings Street Today

- 1** *The Heights*
Medium density retail and mixed-use



- 2** *Capitol Hill*
Residential



- 3** *Lochdale*
Low density retail, open space

A **distinctive, vibrant atmosphere** focused on walkability, comfort, safety, active space is strongly desired

Place



Access is a critical priority for merchants, businesses, and residents

Access



Hastings Street is a **key local & regional connector** that requires reliable travel options

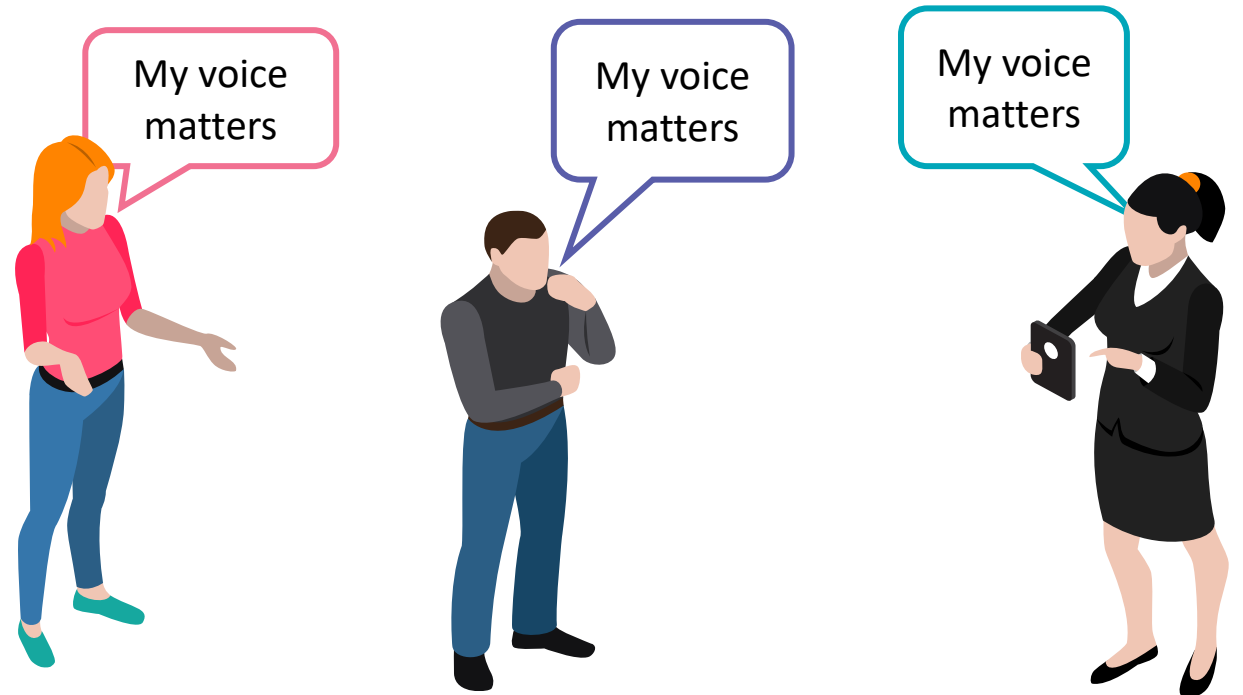


Stakeholder inputs & community survey



Engagement

- Early engagement and interviews

- Hastings St walking tour
- Broad public survey
- First Nations engagement in a separate and parallel process



Public Survey

- May 16 to June 13
- Broad and targeted advertising
- Great response with over 900 completed surveys
- Received input and ideas for each neighbourhood along Hastings St.

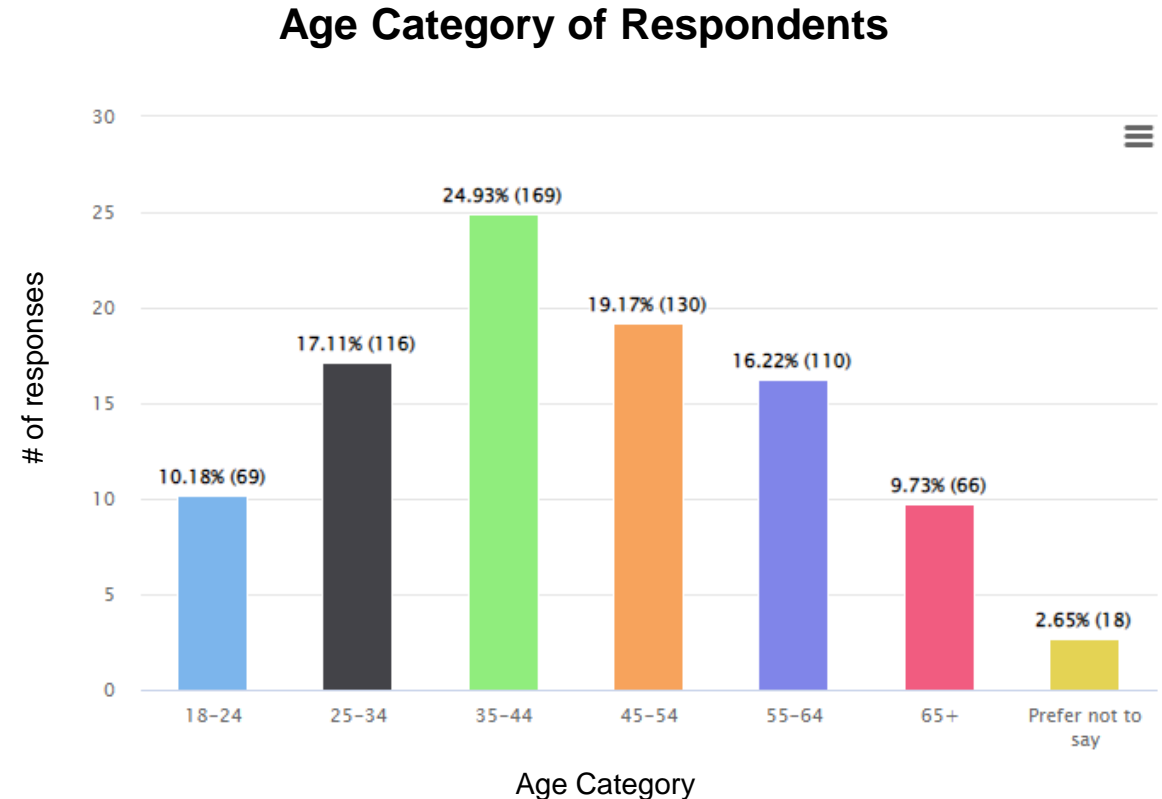

Public Survey Response

- 67% of respondents live on the corridor
- 83% of respondents come to Hastings St daily or several times a week
- Balance of ages and gender
- Received responses from people with disabilities (9%) and those who speak other languages (18%)



Neighbourhood Values

What values are people most interested in commenting upon?

1 *The Heights*

- unique sense of place and character of this segment
- walkability and access to diverse local businesses, ability to park nearby
- strength of access by transit

2 *Capitol Hill*

- uniqueness of businesses
- community greenery & residential character
- limited pedestrian amenities
- regarded as a link between the Heights and Lochdale areas

3 *Lochdale*

- shops and services of Kensington Mall
- landscape & greenery
- wide lanes/good flow of traffic
