Potential Elevated Flare Due to Scheduled Maintenance

The Parkland Burnaby Refinery is preparing for its February 1 planned scheduled maintenance that will ensure safe, reliable, and efficient operations.

Please be advised that neighbours and communities nearby the Refinery may see a higher than usual flare and noise as machinery and equipment is taken off-line to start the maintenance work. The Refinery anticipates an elevated flare maybe visible starting Tuesday, January 31, 2023. The potential for elevated flaring is expected to last 6 to 8 days. All safety protocols will be followed, and all required regulators have been notified.
