








Canada; an extensive coast-to-coast network

- √ 30% of Vancouver International Airport Jet Fuel

Energy for the Future...Now!!!

Playing a leadership role in the production of low carbon fuels

- ✓ First in Canada to ratably co-process renewable materials to create low carbon fuels using our existing refinery, starting in 2017.
- ✓ Our current renewable feedstocks are tallow and canola.
- ✓ Partnerships and innovation are key to our future success with more advanced renewable BC feedstocks, derived from municipal sewage sludge and forest residuals.
- ✓ Climate targets require more renewable fuel produced quickly.
- ✓ Parkland is leveraging existing infrastructure and technical expertise to scale renewable fuel production at the refinery.
- ✓ Evolving our refinery to manufacture more renewable fuels requires modifications.





CleanBC plan seeks 650 million litres/year of renewable fuels by 2030.

Burnaby Refinery – Investments

Improving safety, reliability, and environmental stewardship. Leading Canada's low carbon renewable fuels of the future.

- ✓ Infrastructure for accessing renewable feedstocks, storing in existing tank farm area, and delivering renewable products to customers
- ✓ Co-processing treatment and converting renewable feedstocks into low carbon renewable products
- ✓ Inline hydrogen production for treating and converting renewable feedstocks into low carbon renewable products
- ✓ Additional environmental investments in further reducing sulphur dioxide and other emissions, as well as further air monitoring
