Update: Temporary Portable Flare at Refinery

On Friday, October 31st, a temporary portable flare is being brought into Area 1 to enable safe de-pressurization of a rail car on the property. This process, which will last roughly 24 hours, has a small potential to produce odours, but poses no risk to the community.

The Refinery is committed to safe, reliable and efficient operations. All safety and environmental protocols are being followed, and the process is being overseen by regulatory bodies.
