



RBRA Photography and Videoing Policy

1. Policy Statement

All parents, guardians, and spectators attending Rockingham Basketball & Recreation Association (RBRA) games, competitions, programs or events must adhere to this policy. To protect the safety, privacy and wellbeing of all participants—particularly children—photography and video recording without permission is strictly prohibited.

2. Policy Requirements

- Taking photos or recording video at any RBRA-organised game, competition, training session or program without prior written approval is not permitted.
- Exemptions may be requested only for genuine special circumstances (e.g. family health needs).
- Exemption requests must be submitted via email to: admin@rockinghamflames.com.au.
- All requests undergo a formal assessment process; submitting a request does not guarantee approval.
- Taking photos or video without an official approval letter is a direct breach of RBRA policy.
- Breaches may result in penalties, including suspension or removal from RBRA competitions or venues.

3. Agreement

All players, coaches, referees, volunteers, parents and spectators participating in or attending RBRA competitions and programs agree to abide by RBRA Policies and Codes of Conduct as a condition of entry.

Breaches of RBRA policies may result in:

- Suspension
- Expulsion from competitions
- Removal of RBRA membership (where applicable)
