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FEES, UNIFORM & ELIGIBILITY

2026-27 WABL / State Championships Fees

There are costs associated with playing WABL that all players and families should be aware of.

PAYMENT	AMOUNT
26/27 WABL / State Championships total for the entire year	\$830
2026 State Championships (October-December)	\$200
2027 WABL/GRADING FEES Instalment 1 - February	\$330
2027 WABL/GRADING FEES Instalment 2 - May	\$300

There is also a \$50 trial fee to try out for WABL. Please note, this fee is non-refundable.

Development Players pay Instalment 1 in February (\$330), the same as rostered WABL players, but do not pay the second and final payment due in May. If elevated into a full-time roster spot prior to Round 3 of the WABL season, they become a full-time rostered player for fee purposes and must pay the full second instalment in May.

Development Players may fill in for as many games as required, with no cap on games played. They can only suit up when players are missing, injured or ill and an open roster spot is available. Usage remains at the discretion of the team coach.

TEAMPAY COST \$15 PER GAME (MAIN WABL SEASON ONLY)

Venue entry fee through TeamPay for every player suiting up during the WABL regular season and finals. Spectators are free. There are no TEAMPAY fees for State Champs or WABL grading

Rockingham Junior Domestic Requirements:



To be eligible for WABL selection, players must be registered to the Rockingham Basketball and Recreation Association (RBRA) Domestic Competition.

To remain eligible, players are expected to play in 75% of their domestic team’s games in the RBRA competition, except if an exemption has been granted.

NBL1 Involvement

To support our community and culture of connection from WABL to NBL1, Rockingham Flames WABL teams are engaged in NBL1 game days. Teams participate in a shared roster for floor wiping and pack down during NBL1 home games.



RBRA Code of Conduct

Basketball is a leisure sport that promotes both fun and physical wellbeing. The RBRA Code of Conduct sets the standards expected within the Association and reflects the values of integrity, loyalty, trust, respect and pride. It applies to Board members, staff, volunteers, coaches, players, officials and spectators.

SPORTSMANSHIP	Ensure everyone adheres to the rules and spirit of the game.
EQUAL OPPORTUNITY	Treat each person as an individual deserving equal attention and opportunity.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT	Acknowledge good performances and effort from your team, opposition and officials.
OFFICIALS	Respect the decisions of referees and officials at all times.
FACILITIES	Respect equipment and facilities and care for them as if they were your own.
PRIDE	Take pride in being a member of RBRA.

01	COACH / MANAGER For matters such as court time or expectations, the first point of contact is the team coach or manager. Always allow at least 24 hours after a game before requesting a conversation.
02	WABL ADMINISTRATION If the matter is broader, or you are unsure how to address an issue, email wabl@rockinghamflames.com.au and the team can provide guidance on next steps.
