

OFFICIAL RULES OF THE PRIZE DRAW “MoneyGram UK Ramadan 2026” Promotion

Article 1 : Organization

MoneyGram International Limited, authorised and regulated in the United Kingdom by the Financial Conduct Authority (FRN 502639) and registered in England and Wales (Company No. 03287157) (hereinafter referred to as the “**Organizer**”), is organizing a prize draw (free prize draw) with a purchase requirement and a free entry route entitled “MoneyGram UK Ramadan 2026”

The Promotion will run from February 10, 2026 to March 23, 2026 inclusive (hereinafter the “**Promotion Period**”).

The Promotion is open to any adult individual residing in France, Italy, Greece or Germany, subject to the conditions set forth in these Official Rules.

Article 2: Eligibility Conditions

This Promotion is strictly reserved for adult individuals (18 years or older) residing in the United Kingdom who complete a money transfer via MoneyGram during the Promotion Period, either:

In-store, at participating MoneyGram agent locations in the United Kingdom; or

Online, via MoneyGram in the same countries, using the promotional code: **MGCASH**

Excluded from participation are:

- Individuals who do not meet the eligibility requirements;
- Employees of the Organizer;
- Any person involved in the organization or implementation of the Promotion;
- Spouses and immediate family members (ascendants, descendants, or individuals living in the same household) of the above-mentioned persons.

The Organizer reserves the right to request proof of identity and/or proof of participation from any participant.

Any individual who fails to meet the eligibility conditions shall be excluded and shall not be entitled to any prize, even if selected.

Participation in the Promotion implies full and unconditional acceptance of these Official Rules.

Article 3: Participation Mechanics

Complete a money transfer via MoneyGram during the Promotion Period;

Carry out the transaction from the United Kingdom;

Use the promotional code **MGCASH** at the time of the transaction;

Complete the transaction either in-store at a participating agent location or online via MoneyGram.

Only transactions completed in accordance with these conditions will be considered valid entries.

No additional payment is required to enter this Promotion other than the standard costs (if any) of using MoneyGram's services and/or standard internet access costs.

The Organizer reserves the right to exclude any participant suspected of:

- Fraud or attempted fraud;
- Automated entries;
- Incomplete, incorrect, or non-compliant participation.

Any participation not strictly compliant with these Official Rules shall be deemed null and void.

Article 4: Prizes

4.1 Description of Prizes

During the Promotion Period:

10 (10) winners per week **in the United Kingdom** will be selected;

Each winner will receive a cash amount £150, redeemable at a MoneyGram location from our network in the United Kingdom

The total number of winners will depend on the number of weeks included in the Promotion Period.

4.2 Prize Conditions

Prizes are non-exchangeable, non-refundable, and non-transferable;

For the United Kingdom only.

The Organizer's draw records shall be considered final and binding, except in the case of a manifest error.

Each participant may win a maximum of one (1) prize during the Promotion Period.

Article 6: Winner Notification

Winners will be contacted by email, and/or sms and/or telephone using the contact details provided at the time of the transaction.

It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that their contact details are accurate and up to date.

If a selected winner fails to respond within two (2) days of the first contact attempt, the Organizer reserves the right to conduct a new draw in order to designate an alternate winner.

Article 7: Prize Delivery

Prize details will be delivered electronically or by any other method determined by the Organizer.

Winners agree to accept the prizes as awarded, without the possibility of substitution or compensation.

In the event of circumstances beyond the Organizer's control (including force majeure or supplier issues), the Organizer reserves the right to replace the prize with a prize of equivalent value. Winners will be informed of any such change.

Article 8: Personal Data

Participants' personal data is collected and processed by the Organizer for the purposes of:

- Managing participation in the Promotion;
- Conducting the prize draws;

- Contacting winners and delivering prizes.

The data controller, within the meaning of the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018, is MoneyGram International Limited.

MoneyGram and the Arrow are trademarks of MoneyGram.

All other trademarks are the property of their respective owners.

Any unauthorized reproduction or use is strictly prohibited.

Article 11: Liability

The Organizer shall not be held liable in the event of force majeure or circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

The Organizer shall not be responsible for:

- Technical failures;
- Communication issues;
- Loss, theft, or misuse of prizes once delivered.
- Any additional costs incurred by the winners in connection with prize use shall remain at their sole expense.

Article 12: Governing Law and Disputes

These Official Rules are governed by the laws of England and Wales.

Any claim relating to the Promotion must be submitted within one (1) month following the end of the Promotion. After this period, no claims will be accepted.

The courts of England and Wales will have exclusive jurisdiction, except that residents of Scotland and Northern Ireland may also bring proceedings in their local courts.

Article 13: Evidence Agreement

By express agreement between the participant and the “Organizer,” the Organizer’s computer systems and electronic files shall constitute the sole authoritative records.

The computerized records stored within the Organizer’s information systems, under reasonable conditions of security and reliability, shall be deemed proof of the relationships and communications that have occurred between the Organizer and the participant.

Accordingly, it is agreed that, except in the event of a manifest error, the Organizer may rely—particularly for evidentiary purposes—on any programs, data, files, records, transactions, and other elements (such as monitoring reports or other statements), in digital, electronic, or computer-readable format or medium, that are created, received, or stored directly or indirectly by the Organizer, including within its information systems.

Such elements shall constitute valid evidence and, if produced by the Organizer as means of proof in any judicial or other proceeding, shall be admissible, valid, and enforceable between the parties in the same manner, under the same conditions, and with the same probative force as any document established, received, or retained in written form.

Any transactions of any kind carried out using the identifier and code assigned to a participant following registration shall be deemed, irrefutably, to have been carried out under the responsibility of the participant.
