



Connecting


Welcoming the community

The 'to do' list

Our plans cover several areas of the church building

- Repairing the stonework to provide a safe and watertight building
- Re-landscaping the outside space to look more welcoming
- Conducting an energy efficiency audit and designing a low-carbon heating system
- Creating a level floor in the main church to suit flexible community use
- Installing an accessible toilet
- Adding refreshment facilities to the main space

These areas will be supplemented by new audio-visual equipment, storage and redecorating.

What will it cost?

The whole project will probably cost around £900,000.

We'll split this into two phases, with the first phase costing around £520,000. Even if we get a large lottery grant, this means we'll need to raise a further £300,000 for Phase 1.
