SkiArena Andermatt-Sedrun is ready for skiers This Friday, November 9th, the piste on Gemsstock will be open

Andermatt, November 7, 2018 – The SkiArena Andermatt-Sedrun will also be able to open the cable car to Gemsstock and thus the descent on the «Sonnenpiste» this Friday, November 9th. Despite the warm temperatures of the last few days, the conditions on the 3,000-meter-high Gemsstock are perfect for skiers.

Around 2,000 skiers enjoyed the excellent conditions on the Gemsstock last weekend, where the Andermatt-Gurschen cable car and the 6-seater chairlift Gurschen-Gurschenalp with all their pistes were open. From Friday, the cable car to Gemsstock and the descent on the «Sonnenpiste» will be opened.

With over 120 kilometres of pistes and 22 lifts, SkiArena Andermatt-Sedrun is the largest ski resort in Central Switzerland, extending to the nearly 3,000-metre-high Gemsstock and over the Schneehüenerstock and Oberalp pass to Sedrun in the canton of Grisons. The ski link from Andermatt to Sedrun has been completed for the winter season 2018/19.
