




Step 1: Crafting Your Idea

Before embarking on the event creation process, it's crucial to have a clear vision. Determine the type of event you'd like to host. Whether it's a grand historical multiplayer spectacle or an exciting LAN party, a well-defined concept is the foundation for an unforgettable event.

Step 2: Requesting Paradox Support

To kickstart your event planning, navigate to the Frontlines website's homepage and locate the Quartermaster's Office. Here, you'll either log in or create your PDX account.



Once logged in, you'll gain access to the event application form. This form will ask for essential details:

- Your name.
- Discord handle (if applicable).
- Tournament name.
- Expected number of participants.
- A brief, captivating description of your event.

You'll also need to specify the timeframe for your tournament, including start and end dates, along with the relevant timezone. If you plan to stream the event, provide the necessary URLs. Additionally, you can include links to other communication channels, such as a dedicated Discord server for sign-ups.

Step 3: Choosing Your Support Level

At this stage, you'll define the level of support you seek from Paradox. This step is critical for us to understand whether you're organizing an intimate gathering or a massive bracket-style tournament that could potentially attract hundreds or even thousands of participants.

Chevron Tier

- The Chevron Tier caters to more intimate gatherings, ideal for those looking to organize smaller-scale events. It includes scheduled games, cozy get-togethers, and enjoyable game nights with friends or fellow enthusiasts.



Bar Tier

- Stepping up in scale, the Bar Tier is tailored for larger, multi-day organized tournaments. Here, you'll find competitive brackets, thrilling gameplay, and often live streaming that brings the excitement to a broader audience. It's the sweet spot for those seeking a well-structured gaming competition.





Star Tier

- The Star Tier is for the most epic gaming events. It's a level of its own, only for gatherings that attract an incredible ten thousand or more participants and viewers. It's where gaming reaches its highest point, and people from all over the world come to watch the most intense gaming competitions and incredible shows of skill.



Step 4: Await the Response

After submitting your application, expect a response from the Office of Community Services within 72 hours. You may receive a "yes," in which case your tournament will be featured on the event board, or, in the unfortunate event of a "no," don't despair. Our response will include valuable feedback to help you refine your plans and reapply at your convenience.
