CONDITION:

This work is in very good condition. There are fine feather cracks along the turnover edge with associated pinpoint paint losses at the corners. There are a few minute white accretions or losses in places, primarily to the impasto peaks. When examined under ultra-violet light there is an area which fluoresces at the center lower horizontal edge with associated hairline cracking, as visible in the catalogue illustration.
