

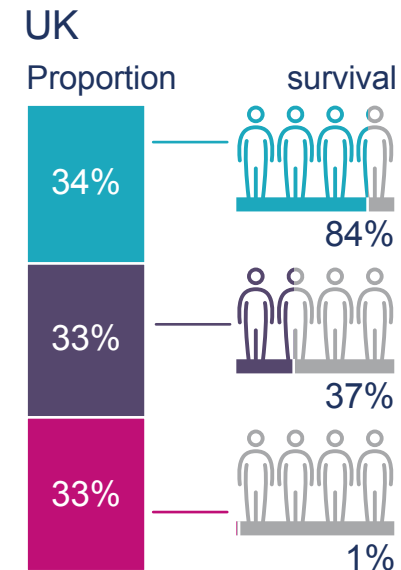
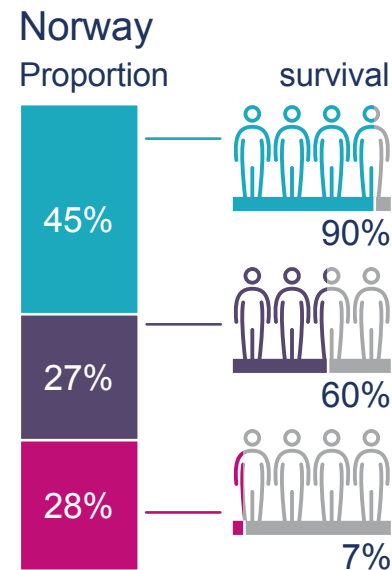
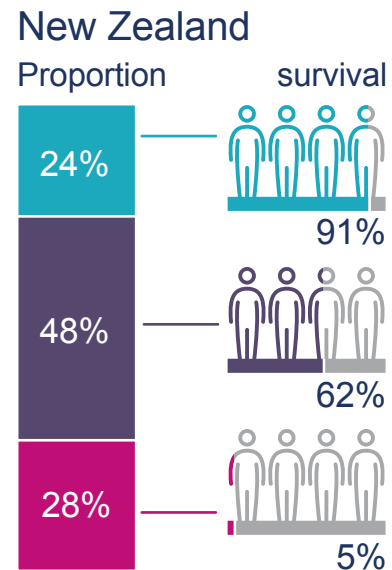
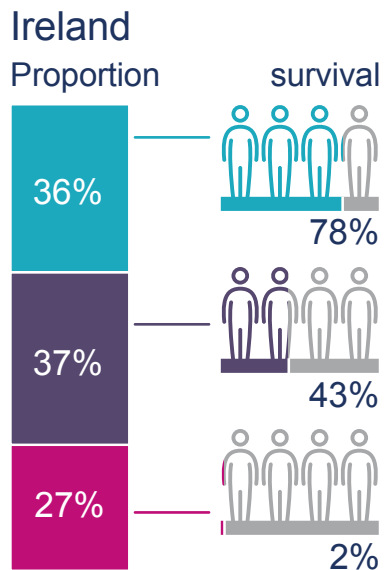
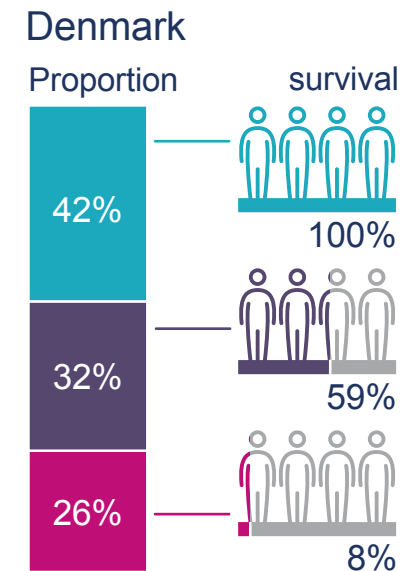
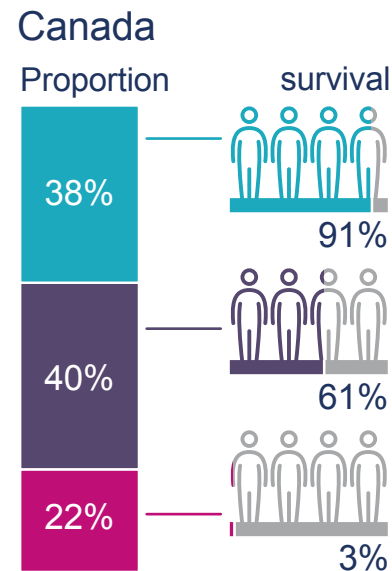
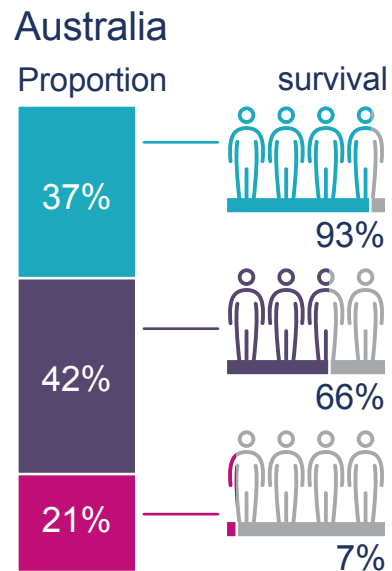
Colon cancer: 5-year survival by stage at diagnosis for patients aged over 80 years

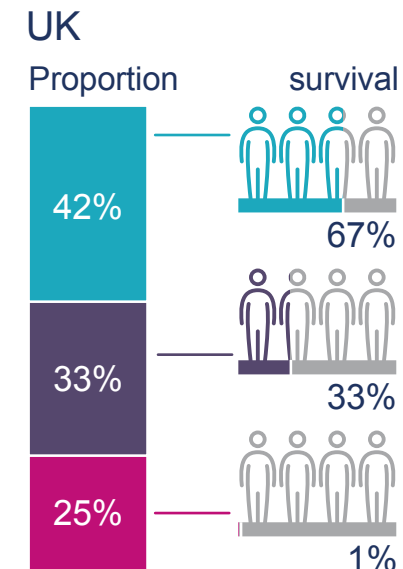
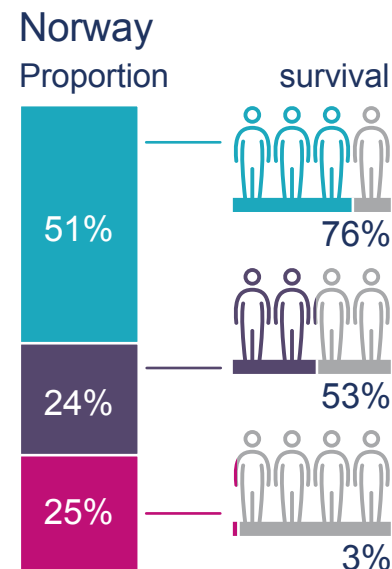
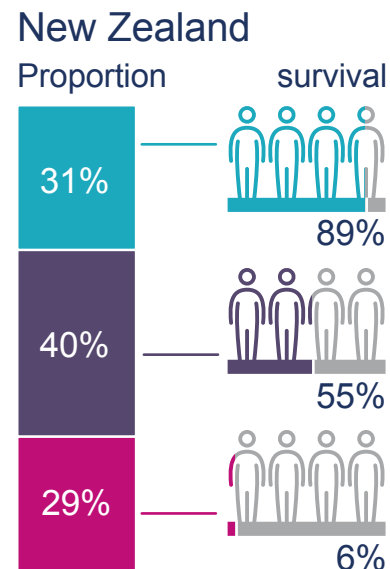
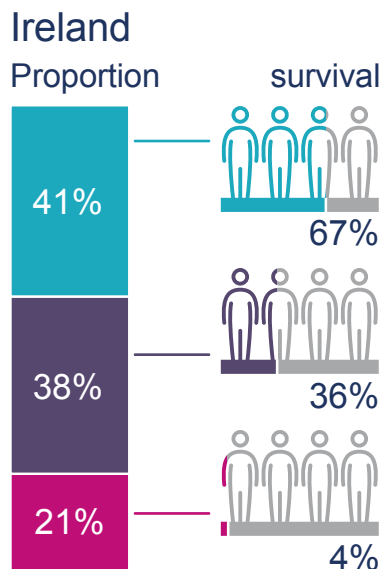
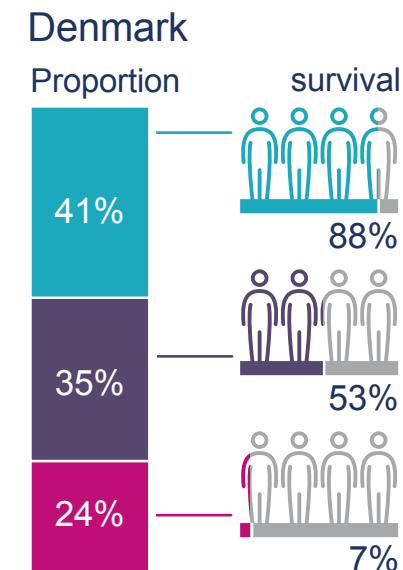
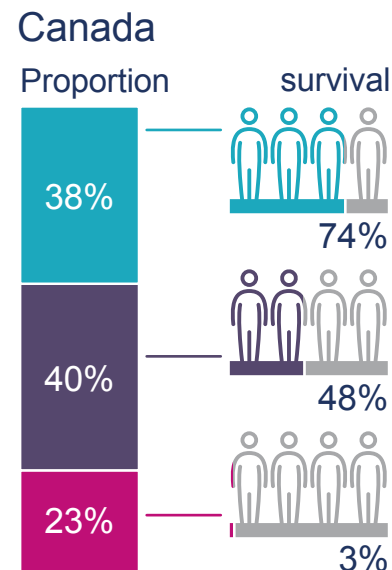
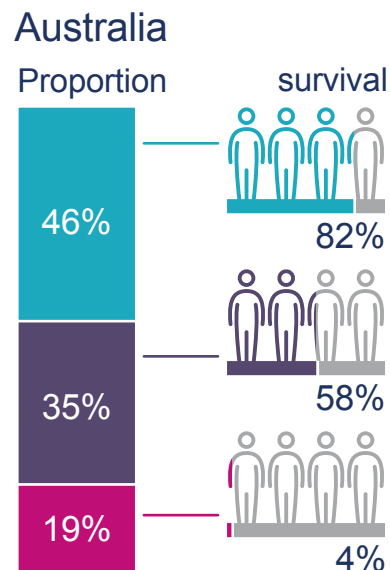
Rectal cancer: 5-year survival by stage at diagnosis for patients aged over 80 years
