How does Gift Aid work?

If you're a UK taxpayer and donate to Cancer Research UK, we can claim tax on your donation at the basic rate of tax that applies for that tax year. Once you've completed this Gift Aid declaration, there is no need for you to do anything else.

All that's required is that you are a UK taxpayer and pay sufficient Income and/or Capital Gains Tax to cover all the Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in that tax year. Please note that it's your responsibility to pay any difference.

We will claim Gift Aid equivalent to 25% of your qualifying donations for the relevant tax year. If you're a higher rate or additional rate taxpayer, you may be entitled to claim further tax relief on the difference between the basic rate that we reclaim and your highest rate of tax. For more information on how to claim this additional relief, contact HM Revenue & Customs or your usual tax adviser.
