Translated versions of the CAM, CAM+, and cancer specific CAM surveys should not use the Cancer Research UK logo and should carry the appropriate notice provided below.

CAM+ notice

This notice should be used for any of the following surveys: CAM+ September 2023, CAM+ February 2023, CAM+ September 2022, CAM+ February 2022, CAM+ September 2021, COVID-CAM+ February/March 2021, COVID-CAM+ August/September 2020, CAM+ 2019, CAM+ 2017 – ONS Survey, CAM+ 2017 – NatCen Panel Survey, CAM+ 2017 – YouGov Panel Survey, CAM+ 2014; and any CAM+ surveys published after September 2023.
