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Trustee and Non-Trustee Committee member Recruitment Principles

1. Council will regularly consider the skills, knowledge, experience and diversity it needs to govern, lead and deliver CRUK's purpose effectively. This will include consideration of skills, knowledge and experience relevant to addressing cancer and health inequalities, ensuring Council is well placed to oversee CRUK's mission to improve outcomes for all. Council will seek to reflect this mix in its Trustee and Non-Trustee Committee Member appointments, balancing the need for continuity with the need to refresh Council.
2. Appointments will be made on merit against objective criteria including behaviours and competencies.
3. Council will adopt an open, formal, inclusive and transparent process for all Trustee and Non-Trustee Committee Members, that ensures there is rigour in the way that new Trustees and Non-Trustee Committee Members are appointed to the CRUK Council and Committees and will advertise all vacancies.
