The Scottish Cancer Conference is a unique gathering of individuals and organisations involved with cancer, from patients to pharmaceutical companies and from clinicians to charities. The next conference will take place on **Monday 23rd November 2026** at the Edinburgh International Conference Centre, The Exchange, 150 Morrison St, Edinburgh, EH3 8EE.

This is a non-commercial event organised and funded by Cancer Research UK on behalf of the Scottish Parliament's Cross-Party Group on Cancer. Last year, the event brought together 200 delegates from a wide range of organisations and backgrounds to hear from a number of key speakers. This Year's Scottish Cancer Conference Theme

We are pleased to announce that this year's theme will be **Nothing About Us Without Us: Putting People at the Heart of Cancer Prevention, Diagnosis, Treatment, Care and Research.**

We want to place people affected by cancer — patients, families, carers and communities — at the heart of every conversation. From preventing cancer to improving early detection, delivering timely, kinder and better

treatment, supporting people to live well with and beyond cancer, enhancing palliative care and accelerating vital research, the conference will explore how Scotland's cancer system can be strengthened when it is developed in partnership with those who use it, not just by those who deliver it. By embedding lived experience throughout the day's sessions and placing patient and public insight on equal footing with professional expertise, the conference aims to reimagine a cancer system that is even more compassionate, collaborative and truly person-centred.

Exhibition Stand Packages

Please note, exhibition stands at this year's Conference will only be available to third-sector and public-sector organisations.

All Exhibition Stand Packages include:

- Exhibition stand including a table (Table sizes are approximately L140cm x W80cm x H72cm)
- 2 free delegate passes including lunch and refreshments.
- Complementary exhibitor listing in the conference programme, on the conference website and post conference report.
- A digital copy of the delegate list ahead of the Conference (names and organisations).

Pricing

£300 – Small organisations (Organisations with an annual income of less than £1 million.)

£350 – Large organisations (Organisations with an annual income of more than £1 million.)

The exhibition stands will be located in the main foyer, as they were at the 2024 Scottish Cancer Conference, which was held at the same venue. Due to venue capacity restrictions, **we are currently able to offer only five exhibition stands.** However, there is a possibility that **up to two additional exhibition spaces may become available closer to the conference date.**

As a result, we can presently confirm exhibition stand allocations for five successful applicants, while a further two applicants will be placed on a waiting list. Please note that we are unable to guarantee exhibition space for those on the waiting list,

and confirmation of any additional availability is unlikely to be possible until one to two months before the conference.

Considerations For Applicants

To ensure that as many organisations as possible have the opportunity to participate in the Scottish Cancer Conference, applications for exhibition stands will be assessed with the following considerations in mind:

- Organisations leading a breakout session will not be eligible to apply for an exhibition stand. Equally, if a topic is being covered in our breakout sessions, then priority will be given to others.
- In line with this year's theme of centring the voices of people affected by cancer, preference will be given to exhibitors demonstrating co-produced projects or initiatives that have been developed collaboratively with individuals who have lived experience of cancer. Priority may be given to organisations that are able to share patient involvement opportunities.
- Priority will be given to organisations that did not exhibit at last year's Scottish Cancer Conference.

We still welcome all applications, however please do bear the above in mind when submitting your application.

Please note that power supply points are also limited. If you require access to power, let us know in advance and we will do our best to coordinate this with the venue.

To submit an application for an exhibition stand, please complete the attached application form and submit to scotcancerconf@cancer.org.uk **by COP on Tuesday 25th August 2026**. Successful applicants will be provided with a code to book exhibition stands through our Eventbrite registration process.
