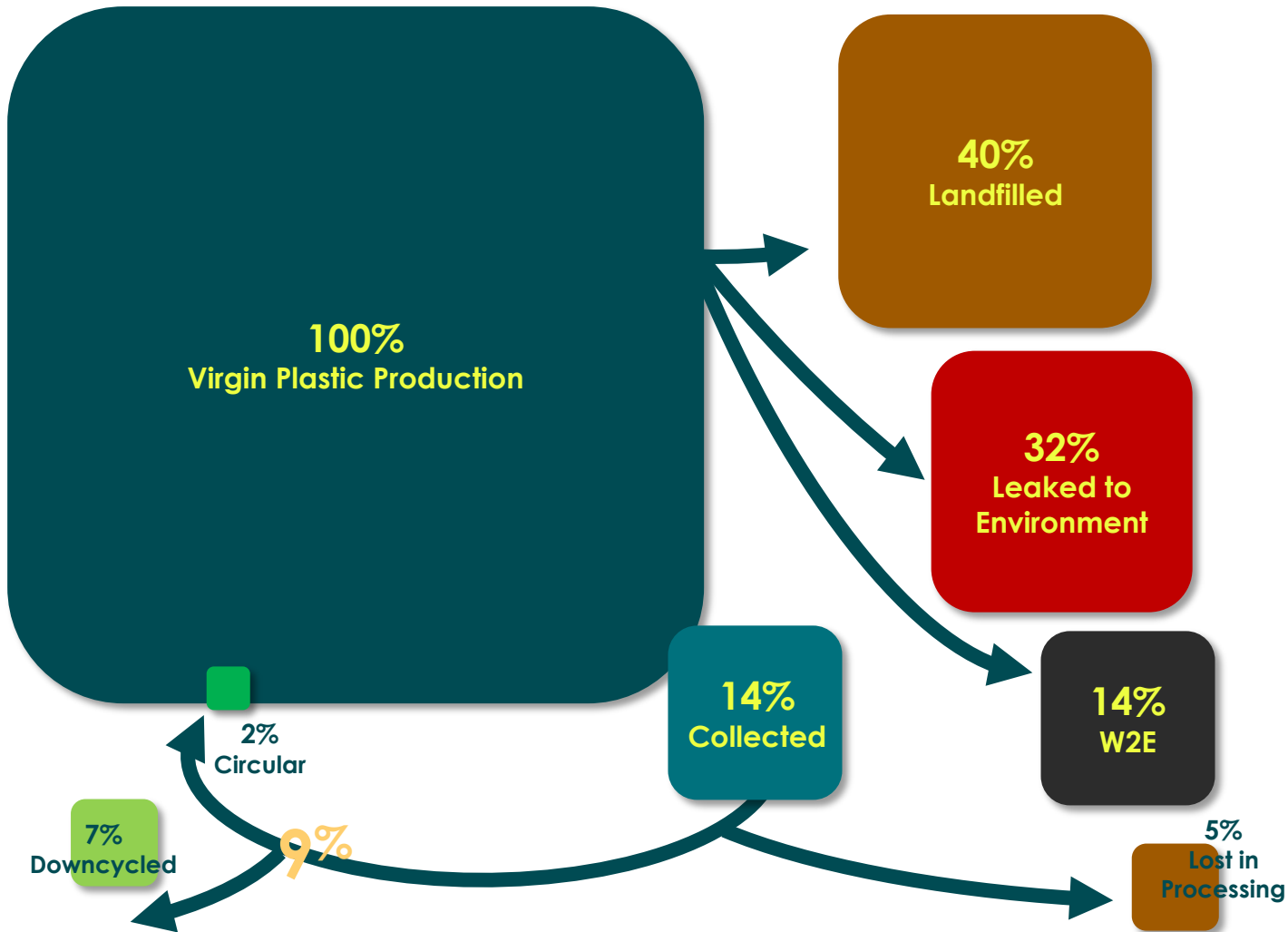

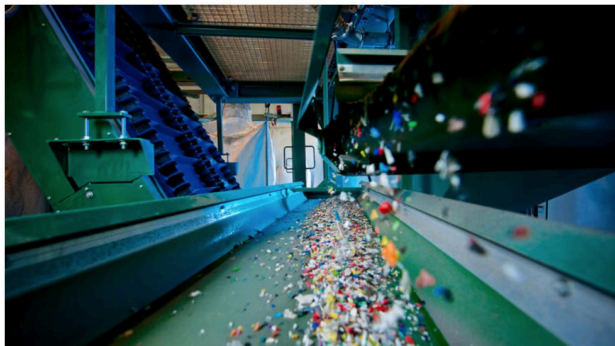

European plastic recycling industry facing 'imminent collapse', says PRE

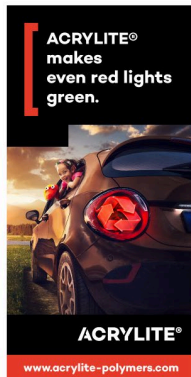

Closures of plastics recycling plants are accelerating in Europe.

Between January and July 2025, Europe lost at least 1.5 million tonnes of recycling capacity, according to a report by Plastics Recyclers Europe (PRE) said in a statement on August 27.

The capacity loss is expected to reach 2.5 million tonnes by the end of 2025.

PRE forecasts a further 1.5 million tonnes of recycling capacity in 2025, after years of rapid expansion. Growth has been slow since 2022, as plastic recycling capacity grew 6% year-on-year in 2023. The previous year the growth was 17%, down from 17% in 2021. This decline is a serious threat to Europe's capacity to meet recycling targets in the PPWR, PRE has forecasted.
