*PSYC 101 and SOCA 101 are required courses for all West Virginia University College of Business and Economics programs, except for Economics. Students who pursue Economics can replace these courses with one General Elective course and remove the second from their plan of study to better align with minimum credit requirements.

**Students are required to complete between 27-30 hours within the Business majors. Students will work with their advisor to distribute Electives to meet the 120 credit hour graduation requirement. Students who choose to major in Marketing at West Virginia University will have one extra General Elective options having completed BUS 208, a required course of the program.

To be admitted to the College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.5. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- ACC 211 & 212
- ECO 201 & 202
- ENG 111 & 112
- MTH 163 & 271
- ITE 115
- BUS 221

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following College of Business and Economics fields:

Accounting; Management; Economics; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality & Tourism Management; Management Information Systems; or Marketing.

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B or higher in ACC 211 and 212; a grade of C or higher in MTH 271
- Economics: One B or higher, and one C or higher in ECO 201 and 202; a grade of B or higher in MTH 271
- Finance: A grade of B or higher in ECO 201 and 202; a grade of B in MTH 271
- Global Supply Management: B or higher in MTH 271
- Management Information Systems: A grade of B or higher in MTH 271

Students are required to complete 3 credit hours from each of the GEF Areas 4 through 7 before successful graduation from West Virginia University. Students are encouraged to study the provided GEF chart to select electives that satisfy these requirements. By using the suggested plan of study above, students are able to fulfill this requirement prior to graduation from Northern Virginia Community College. Students not completing this requirement at NOVA, will need to utilize elective credit at WVU to do so.
