West Virginia University (WVU) and WVU-Parkersburg (WVUP) will in work in partnership to provide ample offerings of all required courses for WVUP students seeking to complete this program-to-program agreement. This could include special sections taught by WVU Adjunct Faculty, or required courses offered on the WVU campus.

Students transferring into the WVU College of Creative Arts (CCA) will be required to audition for admission into the Bachelor of Arts in Music program. For maximum scholarship consideration students are encouraged to complete the application (including audition) before March 1. Students must audition at a performance level three or above to be admitted to most courses of study in music. WVUP students are encouraged to utilize WVU CCA's Audition Days, throughout their first two years, as an opportunity to ensure their successful attainment of proficiency before application to transfer.

Upon transferring to WVU, WVUP students will be required to take a placement exam to confirm their competency in Aural and Written Theory.

Students following this plan of study can complete the West Virginia University General Education Foundations (GEF) requirement with successful completion of approved equivalent GEF courses, or courses on the HEPC Core Coursework Transfer Agreement. Students who do not follow complete the GEF requirements at WVU-Parkersburg, will be required to so at WVU by utilizing 'NON-MUSC ELECTIVES' to do so.
