Students should refer to the WV HEPC Core Coursework Transfer Agreement to select Natural Science courses that will transfer to West Virginia University and complete GEF Area 2B.

Students should refer to the WV HEPC Core Coursework Transfer Agreement to select Math Electives that will transfer to West Virginia University and complete GEF 3

For this agreement, the following course substitutions are being allowed:

- ECON 201 - ARE 150
- ACCT 201 - ARE 110
- BUSA 310- ARE 482
- BUSA 320- ARE 204
- BUSA 330 - ARE 431

*Students are required to complete 3 credit hours from each of the GEF Areas 4 through 7 before successful graduation from West Virginia University. Students are encouraged to take utilize their

Social Science and Humanities electives to take courses that have been approved as part of the HEPC Core Coursework Transfer Agreement accordingly:

- GEF 5 – Social Sci: HIT 104; 105; 240; 241
- GEF 7 – Social Sci: PSY 210; SOC 207; 220
- GEF 6 – Humanities: ENL 200; 201; 202; 204; 219; ART 100; MUS 170

**Depending upon the student's choice in Concentration Elective, the course could be utilized by the program as a Restricted Elective. Students are encouraged to work with their WVU advisor to explore that option. Approval of Restricted Electives for courses not listed as such in the WVU catalog are handled on a case-by-case basis.

ACC 240 (WVU's ACCT 202) has been approved to be utilized as a Restricted Elective.

***ARE 491's summer internship is one of three options available to complete the Agribusiness Management Capstone requirement. Although it is the most commonly pursued option, students may forgo this summer session and complete the requirement via study abroad or thesis composition. Students are encouraged to work with their advisor to select the option that best suits their academic needs and interests.
