AGREEMENT: DIRECT TRANSFER OF STUDENTS WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF CREATIVE ARTS and HARRISBURG AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

West Virginia University College of Creative Arts and Harrisburg Area Community College agree to mutual cooperation in coordinating their respective programs for the associate and baccalaureate degrees. The principal beneficiaries are the students who are served by current information about programs and protected by firm arrangements between institutions of higher education. The students are thereby provided the opportunity of planning a total baccalaureate degree program at the outset of the college education.

PRINCIPLES OF AGREEMENT

West Virginia University College of Creative Arts (WVU) and Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) confirm the following points of agreement, to assure equal treatment of university/college and transfer students.

- 1. This agreement shall apply to students who have completed an Associates degree in Theatre (HACC major #2080) in the transfer curriculum at HACC and shall apply only to application to WVU School of Theatre & Dance Bachelor of Arts in Theatre (WVU major code #2570) or Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre with an Acting area of emphasis (WVU major code #2507).
- 2. The determination of program requirements for a baccalaureate degree shall be the responsibility of WVU.
- 3. For HACC students to be admitted into the Bachelor of Arts in Theatre program, HACC student must meet all current WVU Undergraduate Admissions requirements at the time of application.
- 4. For HACC students to be admitted into the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre with an Acting Area of Emphasis program, the HACC student must meet all WVU Undergraduate Admissions requirements at the time of application and be successfully be admitted into the WVU Studio Acting program via Studio Audition administered by the WVU School of Theatre & Dance. HACC students not admitted into the Studio program may elect to be admitted as a BA in Theatre at WVU.
- 5. WVU requires two (2) practicum credit hours (WVU THET 200) to be completed during the sophomore year. HACC students may receive this practicum credit upon admission into the program; however, they must make a formal request for this practicum transfer (credit be exam) by the end of the first semester of study at WVU. See Appendix II for details on credit available by examination or established competence.

- 6. WVU requires two (2) credit hours of production laboratory (WVU THET 104 & 106) to be completed during the freshman year. In recognition that HACC students complete this work but do not receive academic credit, HACC students may receive this lab credit upon admission into the program; however, they must make a formal request for this credit (credit be exam) by the end of the first semester of study at WVU. See Appendix II for details on credit available by examination or established competence.
- 7. To be assured admission to BFA or BA degree program with the School of Theatre & Dance at WVU with junior level standing, HACC students must the following criteria:
 - Have earned an Associate Arts (AA) degree at HACC
 - Successfully completed the prescribed curriculum requirements for the first eight semesters of the BFA or BA degree program with the School of Theatre & Dance at WVU
 - Meet all of the WVU Undergraduate Admissions requirements at the time of application (as described above in Items 3 and 4)
- 8. The transfer representatives from both institutions, recognizing the HACC general education degree requirements in the transfer programs, shall develop articulated programs of study for students at HACC. These programs of study will be reviewed by the appropriate HACC academic division, which may make suggestions to the WVU transfer representatives about specific course acceptability.
- 9. HACC students transferring to WVU shall be subject to all applicable WVU policies regarding the transfer of credits.
- 10. No time limit (years) shall be placed on the acceptance of credit transferable from HACC to WVU unless there is a specific policy limitation for native WVU students.
- 11. Once accepted to WVU, HACC students transferring to WVU will be treated the same as native WVU students of equal class standing when applying for financial aid and in the award and distribution of scholarship funds.
- 12. Once accepted to WVU, HACC students transferring to WVU will receive consideration for campus housing on the same basis as native WVU students of equal class standing.
- 13. HACC students transferring to WVU will receive equal opportunity to preregister for classes and have access to other student services on the same basis as native WVU students of equal class standing following the initial term at WVU.
- 14. An informal review of programs will occur every two years for the purpose of updating information for students and staff. The review of programs will be initiated by the WVU School of Theatre & Dance.

- 15. This agreement will automatically renew unless personnel from HACC and WVU determine that a meeting is necessary to review and/or amend this agreement.
- 16. This agreement will be reviewed every five years.
- 17. Either institution may terminate this agreement at any time by written notice of at least one (1) year in advance of the effective date of termination.
- 18. Upon formal approval of this agreement, by the appropriate officials of the two institutions, joint advertisement and promotion will be developed by the appropriate representative at each institution.

THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL EDUCATION

WVU aims to provide students with a foundation of skills and knowledge necessary to reason clearly, communicate effectively, and contribute to society. The General Education Curriculum is designed to ensure that students meet these goals through inquiry-based learning across the disciplines. In conjunction with a major field, and in consultation with their advisors, students will design programs of study that satisfy the GEC's Objectives. The learning objectives reflect the fact that, in an increasingly interdependent world, it is crucial that students learn to interact constructively with people from different cultures, to understand viewpoints different from their own, and to identify and resolve issues of personal and professional ethics. The GEC strives to help students to become thoughtful participants in a democratic society, and to achieve the intellectual integration and awareness they will need to meet changes and challenges in their personal, social, and professional lives.

POLICIES GOVERNING THIS CURRICULUM

- 1. Students will take between 41 and 43 credits in this curriculum.
- 2. Most courses fulfill two GEC objectives. The student will choose which one of those objectives a particular course will fulfill.
- 3. Unless disallowed by the major, courses satisfying GEC objectives may also satisfy course requirements for the major.
- 4. Students may fulfill up to three of the GEC objectives 2 through 9 (including 2A, 2B lab, 2B other, and 2C) with courses in one subject area (as defined by a common prefix, such as POLS or SOCA) and may fulfill up to two GEC objectives 2 through 9 with courses in each of any other subject areas. For example, a student might complete objectives 2 through 9 with three PSYC courses, two BIOL courses, two PHIL courses, one MATH course, one CS course, one ART course, and one RELG course. Another student might complete objectives 2 through 9 with two STAT courses, two GEOL courses, two ARHS courses, two ENGL courses, two HUM courses and a THET course. Another student might take courses in 11 different subjects to complete these objectives.
