Students wishing to transfer into the Civil Engineering program must have a GPA of at least 2.25 in all college work attempted and a C or better in all MATH courses.

Although transferred as open credit, LHU's MATH 141, 142, 243 and 244 will be utilized to satisfy the MATH 155, 156 and 251 requirements at WVU.

LHU students transferring in with more than 28 credit hours are exempt from the ENGR 199 requirement.

ENGR 101 will be met by an upper division PHYS course, per Statler College transfer policy.

ENGR 102 must be taken as a transient course online in order to avoid any pre-requisite issues.

The general science elective will be satisfied by PHYS 331.

The ENG Elective will be met by EE 221/222.

Completion of LHU's General Education requirements will be applied to WVU's General Education Curriculum areas 3, 5, 6, 7, 9 and either 4 or 8. The remaining areas 4 or 8 will be fully satisfied upon completion of ECON 201.
