Bad Example

An operator cuts open incoming cartons without wearing gloves, resulting in a superficial hand injury from a utility knife.

Good Example

An operator dons cut-resistant gloves before cutting cartons, preventing any risk of laceration even when the blade slips.

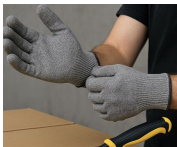

One Point Lesson

- Always inspect gloves before starting the shift.
- Never use gloves with visible tears, holes, or frays.
- Store gloves in designated clean storage when not in use.
- Replace gloves immediately if damaged.
- Gloves are resistant, not cut-proof, still use caution with sharp blades.

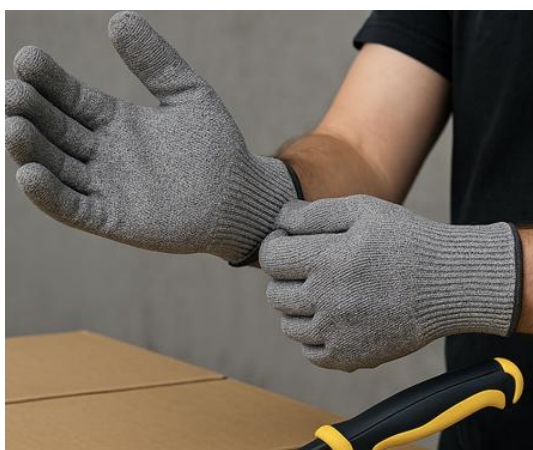
