Furthermore, the Minister is not responsible for notifying present or future site owners/occupants of the work completed. Any persons intending to purchase or occupy property should make their own independent determination of the environmental condition and the extent of liability, which may arise from taking ownership or occupancy.

As the Responsible Party, you are required to ensure that the Site Professional decommissions any monitoring wells, if present, as soon as is practicable. The Site Professional must follow the DELG Guidelines for the Decommissioning (abandonment) of Groundwater Wells and Boreholes (dated March 2021) and <u>must also submit written confirmation</u>, with details of the well decommissioning, to this Department upon completion of this action.
