PAYMENT TERMS

Sales are conducted in EURO.

Purchases must be paid in full within 7 days of the end of the relevant auction.

Interest of 18% per annum will start accruing on the 8th day after the relevant auction together with any legal and collection costs.

Late Payment Fees will be charged on all purchases not paid in full within 7 days after the auction.

Transaction Fee:

Each purchased Lot will be subject to a transaction fee of:

- a) 15% on all Lots selling for EUR 5.000 or less, with a minimum fee of EUR 100 per Lot,
- b) 10% on all Lots selling for over EUR 5.000 up to EUR 12.000, with a minimum fee of EUR 750 per lot,
- c) 4,85% on all Lots selling for over EUR 12.000 up to EUR 75.000, with a minimum fee of EUR 1.200 per Lot or,
- d) EUR 3.638 on all Lots selling for over EUR 75.000.

VAT (Value Added Tax) applies to these fees and must be paid by ALL buyers. Purchases must be paid in full in Euro within 7 days of the end of the

auction. No removal is allowed based on a bank advice or partial payment.

All bids are exclusive of VAT - as applicable - and exclusive of the applicable transaction fees.

network used or managed by, or on behalf of, you or your financial institution.

EQUIPMENT REMOVAL

Lots are mainly stored at Saint Aubin Sur Gaillon, Bressols, Nivolas and Avignon but some lots are located on annex sites, the location will be specified for each lot.

All equipment must be removed within 3 weeks after the relevant auction.

If equipment is not removed within 3 weeks after the relevant auction, the equipment will, at our discretion, either be stored at our facility at a rate of € 25 plus VAT per day per lot, or transported to and stored at a third-party facility, all at buyer's expense.

Items cannot be removed until (1) the entire invoice is paid in full and (2) buyer has no other outstanding balances at Ritchie Bros. or any of Ritchie Bros. affiliates; storage fees apply to late removals.

Insurance and removal are the buyer's responsibility.

Buyer must present a valid registration and road insurance for every vehicle that will not be removed by trailer but will travel on public road.

Yard gates close promptly at 4:00 pm. Trucks for pick-up must be in the yard 30 minutes before closing.

Before equipment will be released from the yard it must be paid for in full and your nominated transport company must present the QR code sent by email. All truck drivers must report to the Yard Office and present a copy of their ID or passport. If you have purchased any NON-DUTY-FREE units, custom papers must have been arranged before collection and handed to Ritchie Bros. before any item can be released from our yard.

Customers and transport companies are responsible for the load out of their purchased equipment in a timely manner. All drivers need to load the non-stationary units themselves. All stationary units will be loaded by Ritchie Bros. Please make sure that a suitable truck will be sent for pick up.

You acknowledge that Ritchie Bros. may decide in its sole discretion to assist in loading or unloading items. You expressly agree to waive, release, defend, indemnify and hold harmless Ritchie Bros. Auctioneers France SAS and its parents, subsidiaries, and affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, and employees from and against any and all claims, actions, losses, injuries, damages, expenses, costs or relief of any nature or kind whatsoever, including without limitation any injury to the Buyer or any other person or any damage to the Buyer's personal property or the property of others, arising in connection with:

- the loading or unloading of item(s), or;
- Buyer's or its transporter's presence on Ritchie Bros.' property, or;
- any of the activities of the Buyer or its transporter carries out on Ritchie Bros.' property, or;
- any assistance provided to Buyer or its transporter by Ritchie Bros. personnel, or;
- use of Ritchie Bros. equipment, or;
- the transport of item(s) including failure to properly secure item(s), or;

LOAD OUT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Safety requirements are presented to transport drivers upon signing into the yard. All transport drivers must abide by our safety requirements and wear a high visibility vest and safety footwear when outside of their vehicle on Ritchie Bros Property. Vests are available at the Yard Office for those who do not have one. Ritchie Bros. is committed to continually improving safety awareness at all our sites.

SALE DAY LOAD OUT PROCEDURE

There will be no stationary load out or forklift assistance until the conclusion of the relevant auction or at the discretion of the Yard Manager. No vehicles or trailers will be allowed in the yard until the conclusion of the relevant auction. Load out of rolling stock will not be allowed until yard management determines it is safe to do so.

Customers will not be able to load out on Sale Day.

No item will be loaded by Ritchie Bros. employees until the last item has been sold.

Ritchie Bros. will not:

- a) load out equipment nor operate loaders after dusk, nor;
- b) arrange for additional equipment needed for load out.

Following the new regulation on technical inspections implemented on the 20th of May 2018 for all vehicles under 3.5 T, any vehicle noted in the catalogue "TECHNICAL INSPECTION UNFAVOURABLE FOR CRITICAL FAILURES" will not be allowed to leave the yard by the road, it is the buyer's responsibility to organize transportation.

Please note that Ritchie Bros. has not investigated the genuineness or validity of documents in its possession. You are invited to inspect any available documents prior to purchasing.

Importation and related obligations

BONDED YARD

The auction is conducted in a bonded yard. Certain items identified in the sale day listing catalogue, or otherwise announced at the auction, as "Non-Duty-Free Circulation EU" have not been entered into the European Union. It is the purchaser's responsibility to satisfy requirements of any kind in respect to the importation of any items into the European Union, or any other country. Such responsibility includes compliance with laws and regulations of the country including payment of taxes and duties, obtaining proper approvals, and complying with any other requirements. The purchaser will engage his own broker. Ritchie Bros will not charge VAT on these lots if properly cleared. Nominal documentation charges to the buyer for clearing the Bonded Yard will apply.

Those items that have not been imported into the EU and are, therefore, not exempted from EU duty will be identified in this catalogue on the item itself as "Non-Duty-Free Circulation EU".

In order to help buyers, determine what documentation is available for a particular item, we have used coloured stickers as a guide. Please note that **THEY SERVE AS GUIDELINES ONLY** and in no way diminish the buyer's responsibility to inspect items prior to purchase. Check with the customs agent.

EUROPEAN UNION MACHINERY DIRECTIVE

Bidder shall determine to its satisfaction as to whether or not any lot is in conformity.

VAT

VAT and other DUTIES as they may apply are the buyer's responsibility. Local VAT will apply in the following cases:

- a) Locally registered companies or items that remain in the country.
- b) EU buyers who fail to provide a valid VAT number and/or EU buyers who fail to provide

valid proof of transport (complete CMR) within 90 days after the invoice date;

- c) Non-EU buyers who fail to provide correct and complete Export Documents and confirmation of exit to Ritchie Bros Auctioneers France SAS within the 90 days since invoice date;
- d) Non-duty-free items (items in the Bonded yard) not subject to local VAT.

Valid proof of transport for EU buyers:

Valid proof of transport for EU buyers: A valid CMR document must mention the full Buyer details in box 1; Ritchie Bros. in box 4; lot number and full lot description in box 6; signature of the receiver in box 24; plus, the rest of the usual information.

The Buyer hereby appoints RB Group as its attorney-in-fact with a limited power of attorney to execute on the Buyer's behalf, all transport documents.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR NON-EU BUYERS

Official Customs documents must be provided by the local Customs Authorities. Ritchie Bros. Auctioneers France SAS must appear as the exporter on the export document. The lots must be clearly described and identifiable. We require the final proof of export (i.e., "exit confirmation" or "goods departed" confirmation), the intention only is not considered sufficient.

Buyers that will export the goods out of the European Union (non-EU buyers) are required to engage with any export agent communicated by Ritchie Bros. and are required to pay a deposit on all items for export bought at the auction. The deposit equals the local standard VAT rate calculated on the purchase price of the equipment. This deposit will be refunded to the nominated bank account of the buyer within ten (10) business days after presentation of Proof of Final Export of all purchased Lots. Non-EU Buyers should provide accurate bank details in order to facilitate timely refund of deposits. You are not allowed to use Ritchie Bros. Auctioneers France SAS to be stated as shipper/sender on the Bill of Lading (B/L) or CMR.

Non-Duty-Free items are not subject to this deposit.

Of course, you are welcome to choose a different shipping company (note: not export agent, which is always mandatory per the above), but please note that we will then have to charge a VAT deposit on all purchases.

Non-Duty-Free items are not subject to local VAT.

NON-LOCAL EU BUYERS

In accordance with local VAT law, all purchases require payment of local VAT, unless all of the following conditions are met:

1. valid and verified EU VAT identification number of buyer;
2. payment for purchases from a bank, not established in the auction country;
3. transport document (CMR) signed and stamped at destination proving that items have physically left the auction country within ninety calendar days of the auction.

If Ritchie Bros. received a valid EU VAT identification number, initially no local VAT will be charged. In the case that afterwards the above conditions are not met, Ritchie Bros. will charge the standard local VAT rate calculated on the selling price of each duty-free item purchased.

Please note that for EU buyers and Non-local EU buyers VAT will be applied when purchases are in our yard for more than 90 days after the relevant auction.
