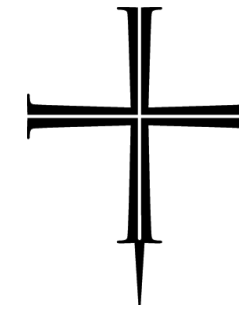

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

THE FIRST LESSON *Numbers 11:24-29*
