WHAT DO I BRING?

Please register on Volunteer Hub before arriving to site, using the directions provided above. Registering online includes completing our mandatory liability waiver. If you do not already have a Volunteer Hub account, please follow the prompts to create one once you arrive at the website.

Wear old clothes, and bring layers in case of inclement weather. You will get dirty. We will provide you with safety googles, but we encourage you to bring your own protective gear for your safety.

Shoes: Wear thick-soled, closed-toe shoes, preferably work boots. Running shoes are OK. Unacceptable shoes include: thin-soled sneakers like converse or keds, flats, shoes with a large heel, sandals, crocs, etc...

FREQUENT QUESTIONS

EXPERIENCE No construction experience is necessary. Our knowledgeable Site Supervisors, AmeriCorps Site Leaders and volunteer Crew Leaders will lead you in building the Habitat way!

SUPPLIES We supply all tools, hard hats, gloves and work belts. There will be ponchos on the truck in case of rain. Our site is always stocked with a cooler of water bottles and we provide a clean port-o-john with hand sanitizer/wipes.

WEATHER We build rain or shine- unless severe weather is predicted. The main office will coordinate with the emergency contact provided on your agreement for the day of the build in the event that the weather turns.

SAFETY Cell phone usage is limited to breaks and lunchtime for safety. Please remember to tag us on social media! Valuable items such as bags or purses can be locked in the cab of the Habitat truck. There is no smoking onsite- you must step to the street line for a smoke break.
