How is the video call Speaking test delivered?

- An IELTS team member will guide you to your Speaking test room and verify your identity.
- Once you have your noise cancelling headset on, you can start your Speaking test on a video call with an examiner who is based in another location.
- You can expect clear sound, secure connections and real-life conversations.

Quick tips

- Speak at your normal volume and pace.
- You can see the examiner, and the examiner can see you, so maintain normal eye contact.
- Always feel free to ask the examiner if you do not understand something. We are here for you.
- Avoid touching your face, mouth or any stationery items during the test.
- You do not need to touch any of the equipment, our team will do that for you.
- Get involved in the interview show off your full language skills, this is your test!
